CLARIFICATION QUESTIONS / REQUEST FOR INFORMATION AND HDOT RESPONSE

FARRINGTON HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS POHAKUNUI AVENUE TO INTERSTATE H-1 FEDERAL-AID PROJECT NO. HSP-093-1(031)

The following RFIs/questions were submitted via HIePRO by prospective bidders as of October 13, 2022. The questions and responses are as follows:

1. Are Post mounted Advisory Boards (Notice to Motorist) Required Per Spec 645.03(G) Advisory Signs. Submit advisory sign shop drawings. Construct, install, maintain, and remove two advisory signs as ordered by the Engineer. Place signs at locations designated by the Engineer. Provide signs, minimum B feet wide by 4 feet high, with black letters on orange background, and with three 4,00 pounds/foot flanged channel posts for each sign? If so, can you please provide the locations?

Response: Yes, they are required. As specified in Standard Specifications, section 645.03(G), two advisory signs are required. The Engineer will coordinate with the contractor to determine the field locations prior to the two weeks before start of construction.

Can used signs, posts and hardware be used for Advisory and Construction Work Zone Signs if they are required for the project?

Response: Previously used signs may be allowed for use providing that they comply with Standard Specifications, section 645.02, paragraphs 50 through 53, as shown in the plans, and as accepted by the Engineer. Previously used signposts and hardware maybe used providing they comply with Standard Specifications, section 750.02(B) and applicable subsection of 750.03, and accepted by the Engineer.

3. May I get the attendees list from the pre-bid meeting?

Response: Attendee list is attached to this Addendum.

4. Due to a large number of projects that we are currently bidding, we would like to request an extension to the bid date of about 3 weeks if possible.

Response: HDOT does not intend to extend the bid opening date at this time.

5. Will there be k-rail available for the contractors use provided by HDOT?

Response: HDOT will not be providing k-rail. The Contractor shall provide its own temporary barriers.
