1. Is the software support required since Milestone, the video software manufacturer, has indicated the system is currently out of software support? This means 16 new camera licenses CAN be added to the system but support for the 16 new licenses CANNOT be purchased unless the whole system is under support which currently has 115 camera licenses.

Software support is not required. Only the new camera licenses to add them to the system.
