- This meeting is to clarify general questions only. If there is a conflict between what was stated in this meeting and the bid documents, the bid documents shall govern. Any significant changes will be issued through an addendum.
- 4. This is a state project utilizing State funds only. Prospective bidders are reminded to comply with all State requirements including using the correct labor wage rates and labor classifications.

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B. General Discussion:

- 1. Important items to attendees' attention:
 - Bid Opening is November 18, 2022 at 2:00 p.m. Bids received after said due date and time shall not be considered.
 - Last day for Substitution Requests is fourteen (14) calendar days prior to bid opening or November 4, 2022. Submit to State DOT Contracts Office, 869 Punchbowl Street Honolulu, Hawaii.
 - One-time only site visit is October 24, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. at EPF location. Interested bidders must email <u>wilfredo.a.estrada@hawaii.gov</u> with your contact information. No Special Badge <u>and PPE not required</u>.
- 2. Project duration is 365 calendar days from NTP. The contract amount for year two and three will remain the same as the bid amount for year one. However, DOT-A will not be obligated to fund the contract for the entire three-year term and will have the option to terminate the contract at any time during the three years. Contractor agrees to begin work within 10 working days from the NTP date and shall finish the entire project within the time prescribed.
- 3. Liquidated damages For failure to provide satisfactory and timely maintenance services in accordance with the specifications as determined by the Director, liquidated damages shall be assessed the Contractor for each and every calendar day at the rate of five percent (5%) of the unit price of the maintenance service items. See page PF-1 for more information
- 4. All of the work is in a secured area. Due to heightened security requirements, there are new security procedures in place. The contractor shall ensure that all access gates are secured at all times. Under no circumstances shall tools, equipment or materials are left in areas where the public can gain access to these items.
- 5. Subject to approval from the Airport Manager, access to the airport will probably be limited through Access Checkpoint 'A'. All vehicles entering the AOA may be subject to search.
- 6. Requests for AOA badges, AOA stickers, ramp licenses, etc. shall be submitted within 14 calendar days after award of contract. In addition to the requirements stated in the Contract Bid Documents, all Contractors shall comply with the requirements and procedures of the Contractor's Training Guide.
- 7. All passes will be signed out and become the responsibility of the General Contractor. The General Contractor will distribute the parking passes among their subcontractors.
