Sand Island State Recreation Area, Oahu, HI Road Resurfacing and Asphalt Patching of Potholes

The Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of State Parks, is interested in procuring bids for a contractor to resurface sections of roadway and asphalt patch potholes at the Sand Island State Recreation Area, as described herein.

Scope of Work

Asphalt Resurfacing of Roadway – Approximately 6 Sections of Damaged Roadway

- 1. Saw cut to create clean squared joints around areas to be asphalt resurfaced.
- 2. Remove 2 ½" of damaged asphalt in the areas to be resurfaced and compact existing base. All damaged asphalt shall be left in a designated area to be determined by the Parks Program Manager or designee.
- 3. Make appropriate slope adjustments to prevent ponding of water.
- 4. If subgrade repairs are required, add additional base rock and compact base to ninety-five (95) percent compaction.
- 5. Spray prime tack coat with SS1-H asphalt emulsion over base rock and exposed edges to be paved.
- 6. Resurface with standard 2 ½" layer of asphalt, state mix no. 5. Compact and connect into the existing pavement and compact to create a smooth transition.

Asphalt Patching of Potholes – Approximately 13 Potholes

- 1. Saw cut to create clean squared joints where potholes are to be asphalt patched.
- 2. Remove 2 ½" of damaged asphalt in the areas to be patched and compact existing base. All damaged asphalt shall be left in a designated area to be determined by the Parks Program Manager or designee.
- 3. If subgrade repairs are required, add additional base rock and compact base to ninety-five (95) percent compaction.
- 4. Spray prime tack coat with SS1-H asphalt emulsion over base rock and exposed edges to be paved.
- 5. Resurface with standard 2 ½" layer of asphalt, state mix no. 5. Compact and connect into the existing pavement and compact to create a smooth transition.

Additional Scope of Work

- 1. When required, the contractor shall provide traffic control personnel during the pothole repair project.
- 2. Roadway paving project shall be done per DOT Standards.
- 3. Provide a Certificate of Insurance (COI) in the owner's name.
- 4. Include 1-Year Workmanship Warranty for roadway resurfacing and pothole repair work.

Bidder shall furnish all labor, materials, and equipment necessary for the relocation of the old asphalt and debris, and installation of the new asphalt materials as described herein.

The scheduling for the resurfacing and pothole repair work shall be coordinated with Eric Kato, Parks Program Manager prior to the commencement of work. His contact number is (808) 733-9102 (office) or (808) 265-2790 (cell).

Workmanship and materials shall conform to the State Building Code of Hawaii (IBC, 2006 Edition as amended by the City and County of Honolulu). However, where reference is made to performance conforming to other standards the more stringent shall apply.

Should the Bidder fail to conform to the requirements herein, the Bidder shall immediately remedy any defects due to faulty workmanship. Should the Bidder fail to comply, the State reserves the right to terminate the service.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

The bid award shall be based on the availability of funds. State Parks reserves the right to cancel the agreement with thirty 30 days advance written notice.

<u>Term.</u> The bid shall be for the six (6) month period commencing from the Notice to Award with requests for services through the State Purchase Orders.

<u>Bidder Qualifications.</u> Bidder shall possess a valid State Contractor's License, classification A or C-3. Bidder shall provide a copy of the license. Award will not be made to any Bidder failing to meet this qualification requirement.

Bidder shall also have a permanent office location from where he/she conducts business and where he/she will be accessible to telephone calls regarding complaints or requests that need immediate attention. An answering service is acceptable provided a response is made within two (2) hours of the initial call.

Bidder shall have adequate equipment and number of employees to perform and complete the work specified herein within the period specified.

Bidder shall be compliant through Hawaii Compliance Express (HCE) pursuant to Chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes. Vendors/contractors/service providers should register with HCE prior to submitting an offer at https://vendors.ehawaii.gov. The annual registration fee is \$12.00 and the "Certificate of Vendor Compliance" is accepted for the execution of contract and final payment. Vendors/contractors/service providers are advised to register on HCE soon as possible. If a vendor/contractor/service provider is not compliant on HCE at the time of award, the Bidder will not receive the award.

Prior to submittal of an offer, Bidder may inspect the location to thoroughly familiarize themselves with existing conditions, rules and regulations, and the extent and nature of work to be performed. Bidder inspection is not mandatory; however, submission of an offer shall be evidence that the Bidder understands the scope of the service and shall comply with specifications herein, if awarded the contract. No additional compensation, subsequent to bid opening shall be allowed by reason of any misunderstanding or error regarding site conditions or work to be performed.

<u>Bid Quotation.</u> Unit bid price shall include labor, materials, equipment, and all applicable taxes and any other costs incurred to provide services specified. (See Attachment 1)

Liability Insurance

The Bidder shall provide a Certificate of Insurance with the following minimum insurance coverage(s) and limit(s):

Each insurance policy required by this contract, including a subcontractor's policy, shall contain the following clauses:

- 1. "This insurance shall not be canceled, limited in scope of coverage or non-renewed until after 30 days written notice has been given to the State of Hawaii, Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of State Parks, 480 Makapuu Ave., Honolulu, HI 96816."
- 2. "The State of Hawaii is added as an additional insured as respects to operations performed for the State of Hawaii."

3. "It is agreed that any insurance maintained by the State of Hawaii will apply in excess of, and not contribute with, insurance provided by this policy."

The minimum insurance required shall be in full compliance with the Hawaii Insurance Code throughout the entire term of the contract, including supplemental agreements. Prior to the commencement of the work, the Contractor agrees to deposit with the State of

Hawaii certificate(s) of insurance necessary to satisfy the State that the insurance provisions have been complied with.

Failure of the Contractor to provide and keep in force such insurance shall be regarded as material default, entitling the State to exercise any or all the remedies provided for the termination of services. The procuring of such required insurance shall not be construed to limit

Contractor's liability hereunder nor to fulfill the indemnification provisions and requirements. Notwithstanding said policy or policies of insurance, Contractor shall be obliged for the full and total amount of any damage, injury, or loss caused by negligence or neglect connected with the services.

Bond. A bond in the amount of the Contract Award shall be required. This bond shall be retained until the DSP Designated Project Manager has determined that all work in conformance with this Scope of Work has been satisfactorily completed.

<u>Certificate of Insurance</u>. A certificate of insurance shall be required naming the State as additional insured.

<u>Applicable Laws</u>. The Bidder shall comply with all applicable laws of the federal, state and county governments to include but not limited to laws relating to workers' compensation, unemployment compensation and worker safety.

<u>Due Care</u>. The Bidder and its employees shall at all times use due care for the public's safety in its operations and shall be responsible for its own actions.

Start of Work. Work will commence as indicated on the purchase order(s) issued by the Department of Land and Natural Resources.

<u>Time of Completion.</u> The work shall be completed within one hundred twenty (120) working days from the commencement date on the purchase order or as indicated by the Parks Program Manager.

In the event the Bidder fails to complete the work within the specified period, liquidated damages will be assessed.

<u>Liquidated Damages.</u> Liquidated damages are fixed at a sum of THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00) per each and every calendar day the Bidder fails to perform in whole or in part any of his obligations specified herein. Liquidated damages, if assessed, may be deducted from any payments due or to become due to the Bidder.

<u>Campaign Contributions</u>. CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS BY STATE AND COUNTY CONTRACTORS PROHIBITED If awarded a contract in response to this solicitation. Offeror agrees to comply with HRS §11-355, which states that campaign contributions are prohibited from a State and county government contractor during the term of the contract if the contractor is paid with funds appropriated by the legislative body between the execution of the contract through the completion of the contract.

<u>Indemnification.</u> The Contractor shall agree, in behalf of its employees, subcontractors, and other representatives acting upon its behalf, indemnify, defend, and hold harmless DLNR, its officials, employees, representatives, and agents, against any claim or liability, including all loss, damages, costs, expenses, attorney fees, and penalties, for any damage to real or personal property, including environmental damage, or injury to or death of persons, or violations of or noncompliance with applicable law, when such penalties, damage, injury or death results from, arises out of, or is connected with the completion of the project.
