The following documents shall be included with the vehicle upon deliver to the stated location:

1. Hawaii Safety Inspection Certificate (in duplicate) and Safety Inspection Decal
2. Application for Registration of Passenger Carrying Motor Vehicle Form (Latest Version)
3. Odometer Certificate
4. Notarized Certificate
5. Certificate of Weight and Measures (required if factory-furnished) vehicle weight is unavailable, which shall include make, model, year, and vehicle identification number. Verified weight in pounds must be official machine-stamped (handwritten weight shall not be accepted).
6. Certificate of origin
7. Temporary license plates to be used during the interim period prior to acquisition of State of Hawaii plates.

Acceptance of payment for the vehicle delivered will not be made without the inclusion of the required documents and certificates. The State shall be responsible for registration and obtaining licenses for these vehicles.
