I. INTRODUCTION

II. IMPORTANT ITEMS

1. This meeting is to clarify general questions only. If there is a conflict between what was stated in this meeting and the bid documents, the bid documents shall govern. Any significant changes will be issued through an addendum. A copy of the meeting minutes will be issued to all attendees.
2. Deadline for questions is June 1, 2023, at 2:00 p.m. Hawaii Standard Time.

All questions must be submitted in writing, in PDF format, via email (jonathan.r.yoshida@hawaii.gov) followed by hardcopy (400 Rodgers Boulevard, Suite 700, Honolulu, HI 96819) to the State Project Manager, Jonathan Yoshida.
3. Bid opening date is June 15, 2023, at 2:00 p.m. Hawaii Standard Time.
4. The scope of work consists of replacing existing fire exit doors.
5. To be eligible for award, bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii General Building Contractor's "B" license at the time of bidding.
6. Completion time is 365 Calendar days from the date indicated in the Notice to Proceed from the Department.

7. Bidders must complete all unit prices and amounts. Failure to do so may be grounds for rejection of bid.
8. All work is within Customs and Border Protection (CBP) areas and additional security requirements of the CBP will apply (ex. CBP Form 3078).
9. Due to the security requirements of the areas, Contractor work sites must have a full plywood barricade partition to secure access to their work site, the CBP area, and airport secure areas.
10. Since the emergency exits will be blocked during the work, the Contractor must provide temporary signage and alternate evacuation routes.

III. GENERAL DISCUSSIONS

1. Site visit needs to be coordinated with Customs and Border Protection (CBP). Attendees must provide their full legal name and date of birth during this prebid meeting for background checks to access the area. The site visit is tentatively scheduled for Tuesday, May 23, 2023, at 2:00 p.m., meeting at the Ewa end of Terminal 2, on the ground floor, outside the CBP office (near access-controlled door IAB-OG-22)

2. Question: What are the work hours for the project? After hours or flexible?

Response: There are limits for dust, noise, and power outages with airport operations but work inside the barricades can be more flexible.

3. Question: What is the process for work on access-controlled doors?

Response: Coordination with the Airport will be through the Construction Manager. Outage requests should be submitted two weeks in advance.

4. Question: Are staging areas available?

Response: Section 01010 – Description of Work, 1.09 Provisions for Field Office/Storage Space has a description of the process to request for storage space. The State will make every effort to provide space but cannot guarantee space to the Contractor's requirements will be available.

5. Question: Is the work to replace doors in kind?

Response: The work is replacing existing exit doors. Some doors have transoms and other features in the existing frame that are to be replaced with gypboard walls. Also, the new doors should have external vertical rods compared to the existing internal

vertical rods.

6. Question: Will door schedules and hardware schedules be provided to bidders?

Response: No, the schedules are to be developed by the Contractor and submitted as part of the work.
