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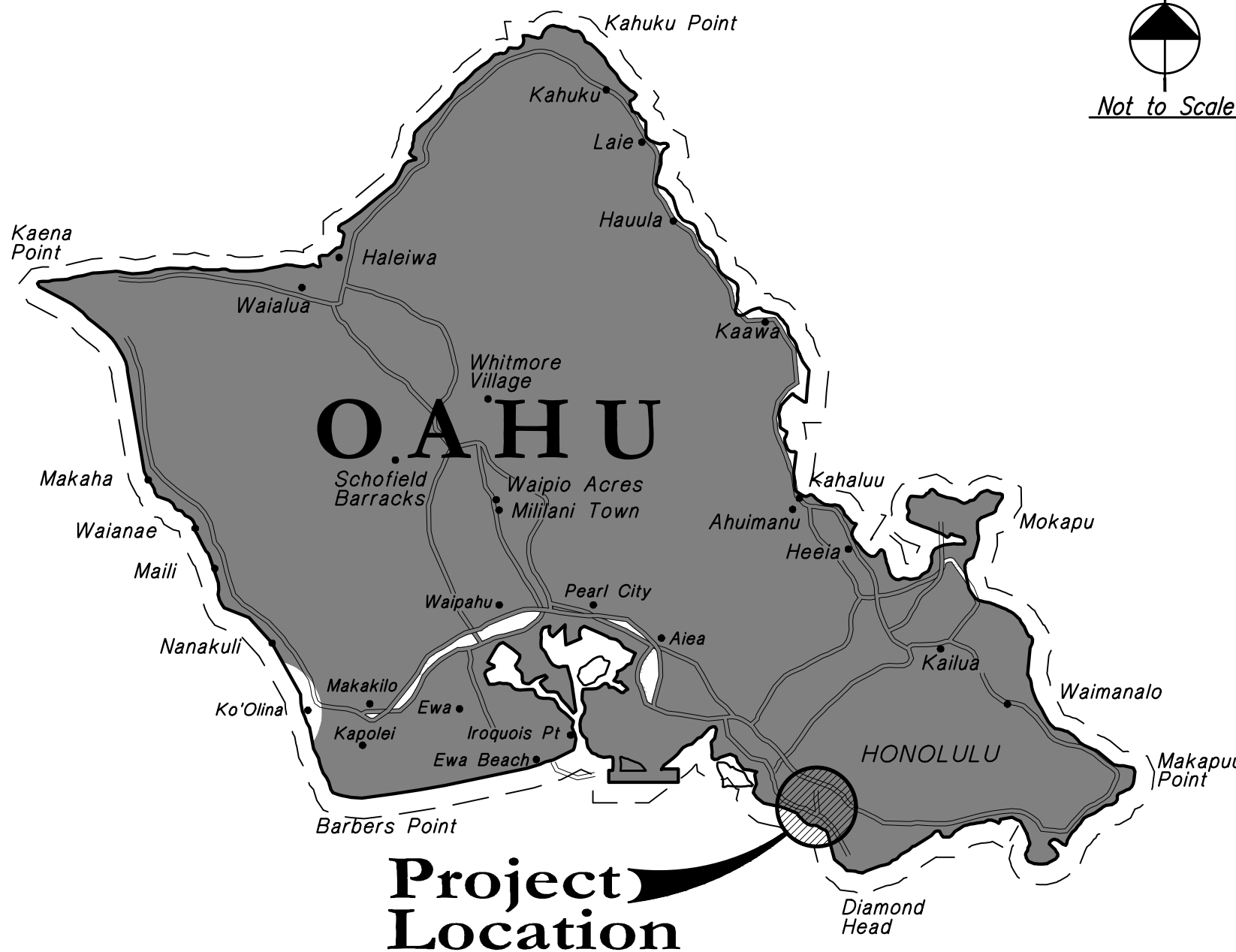

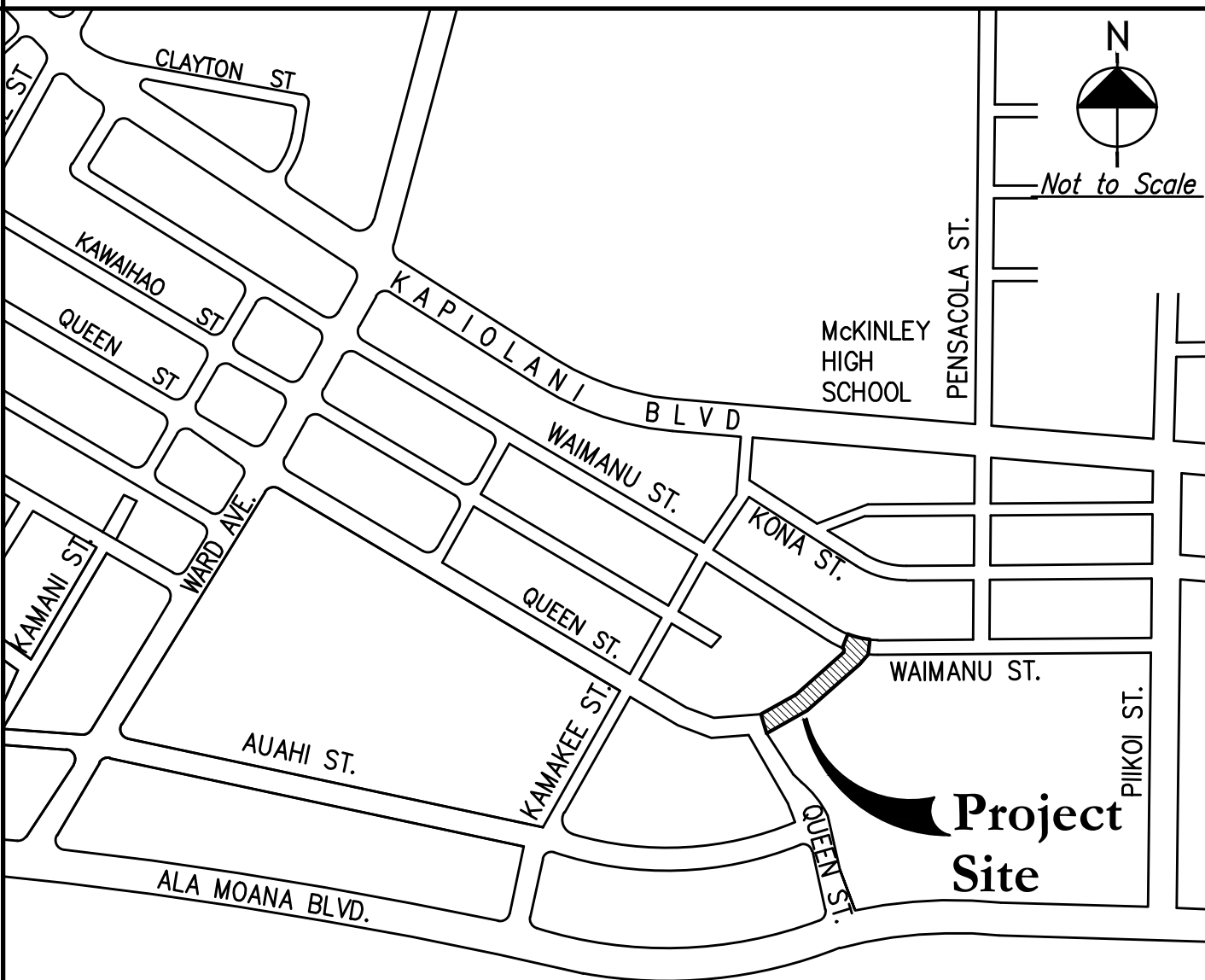

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	GENERAL CONSTRUCTION NOTES					
E	1. ALL APPLICABLE CONSTRUCTION WORK SHALL BE DONE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION, SEPTEMBER 1986, AND STANDARD DETAILS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION, SEPTEMBER 1984, AS AMENDED, OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU AND THE COUNTIES OF KAUAI, MAUI, AND HAWAII. 2. THE UNDERGROUND PIPES, CABLES AND DUCTLINES KNOWN TO EXIST BY THE ENGINEER FROM HIS SEARCH OF RECORDS ARE INDICATED ON THE PLANS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THE LOCATIONS AND DEPTHS OF THE FACILITIES AND EXERCISE PROPER CARE IN EXCAVATING THE AREA. WHEREVER CONNECTIONS OF NEW UTILITIES TO EXISTING UTILITIES ARE SHOWN ON THE PLANS, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL EXPOSE THE EXISTING LINES AT THE PROPOSED CONNECTION TO VERIFY THEIR LOCATIONS AND DEPTHS PRIOR TO EXCAVATION FOR THE NEW LINES. 3. NO CONTRACTOR SHALL PERFORM ANY CONSTRUCTION OPERATION SO AS TO CAUSE FALLING ROCKS, SOIL OR DEBRIS IN ANY FORM TO FALL, SLIDE OR FLOW INTO EXISTING CITY DRAINAGE SYSTEMS, OR ADJOINING PROPERTIES, STREETS OR NATURAL WATERCOURSES. SHOULD SUCH VIOLATIONS OCCUR, THE CONTRACTOR MAY BE CITED AND THE CONTRACTOR SHALL IMMEDIATELY MAKE ALL REMEDIAL ACTIONS NECESSARY. 4. THE GENERAL CONTRACTOR/DEVELOPER/OWNER OF THE PROJECT SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR CONFORMANCE WITH APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THE HAWAII ADMINISTRATIVE RULES, TITLE 11, CHAPTER 54, "WATER QUALITY STANDARDS," AND TITLE 11, CHAPTER 55, "WATER POLLUTION CONTROL", AS WELL AS CHAPTER 14 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF HONOLULU, AS AMENDED. BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES SHALL BE EMPLOYED AT ALL TIMES DURING CONSTRUCTION. THE GENERAL CONTRACTOR/DEVELOPER/OWNER OF THE PROJECT SHALL OBTAIN NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT COVERAGES(S) FOR THE FOLLOWING: 1. STORM WATER DISCHARGE ASSOCIATED WITH CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES THAT DISTURB ONE (1) ACRE OR MORE, AND 2. DISCHARGE OF HYDROTESTING EFFLUENT, DEWATERING EFFLUENT, AND WELL DRILLING EFFLUENT TO STATE WATERS. IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE LAW, ALL DISCHARGES RELATED TO PROJECT CONSTRUCTION OR OPERATIONS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH STATE WATER QUALITY STANDARDS (HAWAII ADMINISTRATIVE RULES, CHAPTER 11–54). BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES SHALL BE USED TO MINIMIZE OR PREVENT THE DISCHARGE OF SEDIMENT, DEBRIS, AND OTHER POLLUTANTS TO STATE WATERS. CONFINED SPACE FOR ENTRY BY CITY PERSONNEL, INCLUDING INSPECTORS, INTO A PERMIT REQUIRED CONFINED SPACE AS DEFINED IN 29 CFR PART 1910.146(b), THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING: I. ALL SAFETY EQUIPMENT REQUIRED BY THE CONFINED SPACE REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL PARTIES OTHER THAN THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY, TO INCLUDE, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING: A. FULL BODY HARNESSES FOR UP TO TWO PERSONNEL. B. LIFELINE AND ASSOCIATED CLIPS. C. INGRESS/EGRESS AND FALL PROTECTION EQUIPMENT. D. TWO–WAY RADIOS (WALKIE–TALKIES) IF OUT OF LINE–OF SIGHT. E. EMERGENCY (ESCAPE) RESPIRATOR (10 MINUTE DURATION). F. CELLULAR TELEPHONE TO CALL FOR EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE. G. CONTINUOUS GAS DETECTOR (CALIBRATED) TO MEASURE OXYGEN, HYDROGEN SULFIDE CARBON MONOXIDE AND FLAMMABLES (CAPABLE OF MONITORING AT A DISTANCE AT LEAST 20–FEET AWAY). H. PERSONAL MULTI–GAS DETECTOR TO BE CARRIED BY INSPECTOR. II. CONTINUOUS FORCED AIR VENTILATION ADEQUATE TO PROVIDE SAFE ENTRY CONDITIONS. III. ONE ATTENDANT/RESCUE PERSONNEL TOPSIDE (TWO, IF CONDITIONS WARRANT IT) 6. PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 6E, HRS, IN THE EVENT ANY ARTIFACTS OR HUMAN REMAINS ARE UNCOVERED DURING CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL IMMEDIATELY SUSPEND WORK AND NOTIFY THE HONOLULU POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES–HISTORIC PRESERVATION DIVISION (692–8015). IN ADDITION, FOR NON–CITY PROJECTS, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL INFORM THE CIVIL ENGINEERING BRANCH, DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND PERMITTING (768–8084); AND FOR CITY PROJECTS, NOTIFY THE RESPONSIBLE CITY AGENCY. 7. FOR PROJECTS ABUTTING STATE HIGHWAY’S RIGHTS–OF WAY, THE OWNER OR HIS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE SHALL NOTIFY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, HIGHWAYS DIVISION, OAHU DISTRICT, DRAINAGE DISCHARGE UNIT AT 831–6793 FOR AN ASSESSMENT OF STATE HIGHWAYS PERMIT REQUIREMENTS. 8. FOR BENCH MARK, SEE SHEET C–05. 9. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE CIVIL ENGINEERING BRANCH, DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING & PERMITTING AT 768–8084 TO ARRANGE FOR INSPECTION SERVICES AND SUBMIT TWO (2) SETS OF APPROVED CONSTRUCTION PLANS SEVEN (7) DAYS PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF CONSTRUCTION. 10. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR VERIFYING THE LOCATIONS AND INVERTS OF ALL EXISTING UTILITIES AND DRAINAGE SYSTEMS WHETHER SHOWN ON PLANS OR NOT, PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF CONSTRUCTION.

E	1. A PERMIT SHALL BE OBTAINED FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES BEFORE WORK ON ANY PORTION OF A PUBLIC STREET OR HIGHWAY MAY BEGIN. CONSTRUCTION TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES AND/OR THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND PERMITTING MUST BE PROVIDED WHEN APPLYING FOR THE PERMIT. 2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE, INSTALL, AND MAINTAIN ALL NECESSARY SIGNS AND OTHER PROTECTIVE FACILITIES, WHICH SHALL CONFORM WITH THE "HAWAII ADMINISTRATION RULES GOVERNING THE USE OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AT WORK SITES ON OR ADJACENT TO PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS" ADOPTED BY THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION, AND THE CURRENT U.S. FEDERAL HIGHWAYS ADMINISTRATION'S "MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES FOR STREET AND HIGHWAYS. DURING WORKING HOURS, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE FOR THROUGH TRAFFIC. DURING NON–WORKING HOURS, ALL TRENCHES SHALL BE COVERED WITH SAFE NON–SKID BRIDGING MATERIAL AND ALL LANES SHALL BE OPEN TO TRAFFIC. 5. AS REQUIRED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE OFF–DUTY POLICE OFFICERS TO CONTROL THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC. 6. WHERE PEDESTRIAN WALKWAYS EXIST, THEY SHALL BE MAINTAINED IN PASSABLE CONDITION OR OTHER FACILITIES FOR PEDESTRIANS SHALL BE PROVIDED. CONTRACTOR SHALL REFERENCE TO THE APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND PERMITTING, ALL EXISTING TRAFFIC SIGNS, POSTS AND PAVEMENT MARKINGS PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF CONSTRUCTION. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL REPLACE OR REPAIR ALL TRAFFIC SIGN, POSTS AND PAVEMENT MARKINGS DISTURBED BY HIS ACTIVITIES. 9. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND PERMITTING AT 768–8084 ONE (1) WEEK PRIOR TO ANY WORK TO BE DONE ON SIGNS, POST AND PAVEMENT MARKINGS. 10. NO EQUIPMENT SHALL BE STORED WITHIN STREET RIGHT–OF–WAY EXCEPT AT LOCATIONS DESIGNATED IN WRITING AND APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES. 11. HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (HCDA). SHALL ENSURE THAT THE CONTRACTOR INSTALLS THE CONSTRUCTION TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MUTCD AND THE HAWAII ADMINISTRATION RULES AS SPECIFIED IN TRAFFIC NOTE #2.

E	1. PERFORM ALL WORK IN A NEAT AND WORKMANLIKE MANNER AND IN CONFORMITY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 14, REVISED ORDINANCE OF HONOLULU 1990, AS AMENDED, OR AS MANY BE SUBSEQUENTLY AMENDED. 2. BEFORE PAVEMENT RESTORATION MAY COMMENCE, NOTIFY THE DIRECTOR OR AN AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE AND FURNISH DATA ON TESTS PERFORMED UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A REGISTERED CIVIL ENGINEER SUBSTANTIATING THAT THE BACKFILL HAS BEEN COMPACTED TO THE DENSITY SPECIFIED IN THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION FOR ALL TRENCHES THAT ARE OVER 2 FEET IN DEPTH IN MAJOR AND SECONDARY STREETS AND FOR ALL TRENCHES OVER FIFTY FEET IN LENGTH AND OVER 2 FEET IN DEPTH IN MINOR AND DEAD END STREETS. THE DIRECTOR MAY ALSO REQUIRE COMPACTION TESTS OF BACKFILL FOR HOLES AND FOR TRENCHES IN LESS THAN 2 FEET IN DEPTH AND ADDITIONAL COMPACTION TESTS ON TRENCHES FOR WHICH THE PERMITTEE HAS FURNISHED TEST DATA. 3. CONTACT THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND PERMITTING, SITE DEVELOPMENT DIVISION, CIVIL ENGINEERING BRANCH, PERMITTING AND INSPECTION SECTION TO SCHEDULE A FINAL INSPECTION OF PAVEMENT RESTORATION WORK. THE BOND FILED WITH THE CITY WILL BE RELEASED ONE (1) WEAR AFTER THE DATE OF FINAL INSPECTION. (PHONE NUMBER: 768–8084) 4. PROVIDE SHORING AND TEMPORARY TRENCH COVERS ADEQUATE TO SUPPORT LEGAL TRAFFIC LOADS. 5. ACCOMPLISH EMERGENCY WORK INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO PATCHING HOLES, REPAIRING TEMPORARY TRENCH COVERS AND INSTALLATION OF WARNING LIGHTS OR BARRICADES WHEN THE "CONTACT FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS" FURNISHED BY THE APPLICANT IS NOTIFIED. IF THE EMERGENCY WORK IS NOT MADE IN THE REASONABLE TIME WHEN NOTIFIED OR UPON FAILURE OF THE "CONTACT FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS" RESPOND AND PAY THE COST OF EMERGENCY WORK MADE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF FACILITY MAINTENANCE, DIVISION OF ROAD MAINTENANCE. 6. IN ADDITIONAL, FOR NON–CITY PROJECTS, INFORM THE CIVIL ENGINEERING BRANCH, D.P.P. (768–8084); AND FOR CITY PROJECTS, NOTIFY THE RESPONSIBLE CITY AGENCY. 7. UNDERTAKE, FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR AFTER THE SATISFACTORY COMPLETION AND APPROVAL OF RESTORATION WORK, ANY NECESSARY REPAIRS TO RESTORED WORK OR FACILITIES DISTURBED AND/OR BY THE WORK PERFORMED UNDER THIS PERMIT. 8. REMOVE, RELOCATE, REPLACE, RECONSTRUCT OR ADJUST, AT HIS/HER OWN EXPENSE, ANY OF HIS/HER FACILITIES THAT MAY EXIST ON OR UNDER RIGHT WAY WHENEVER AND AS OFTEN AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE DIRECTOR OR AN AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ORDER TO UNDERTAKE THE CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION OR MAINTENANCE OF SAID RIGHT OF WAY. 9. SUBMIT AS–BUILT DRAWING TO THE DIRECTOR SHOWING THE ACTUAL CONSTRUCTION PERFORMED. AS–BUILT DRAWING ARE NOT REQUIRED FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS AND SERVICE CONNECTIONS. 13. THE PERMIT FEE IS NOT REFUNDABLE UNDER ANY CONDITION.

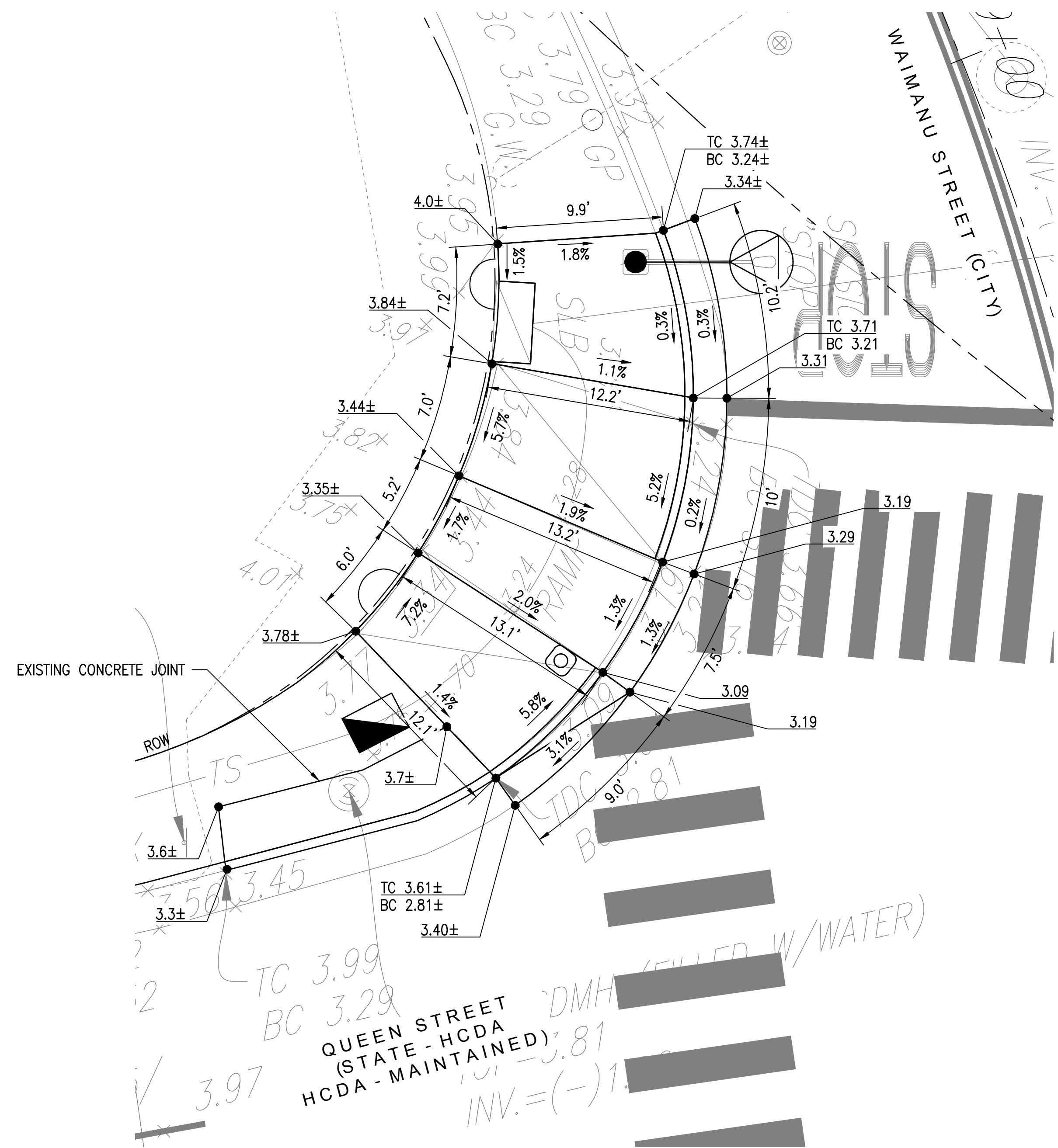


CURB RAMPS #1, 2 & 3 PLAN

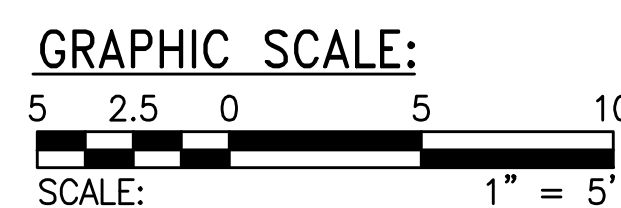

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GENERAL NOTES FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN

1. THE PERMITTEE SHALL MAKE MINOR ADJUSTMENTS AT INTERSECTIONS, DRIVEWAYS, BRIDGES, STRUCTURES, ETC., TO FIT FIELD CONDITIONS.

2. CONES OR DELINEATORS SHALL BE EXTENDED TO POINT WHERE THEY ARE VISIBLE TO APPROACHING TRAFFIC.

3. TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES SHALL BE INSTALLED SUCH THAT THE SIGN OR DEVICE FARTHEST FROM THE WORK AREA IS PLACED FIRST. THE OTHERS SHALL THEN BE PLACED PROGRESSIVELY TOWARD THE WORK AREA.

4. REGULATORY AND WARNING SIGNS WITHIN THE CONSTRUCTION ZONE THAT ARE IN CONFLICT WITH THE TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS SHALL BE REMOVED OR COVERED.

5. FLAGGERS AND/OR POLICE OFFICERS SHALL BE IN SIGHT OF EACH OTHER OR IN DIRECT COMMUNICATION AT ALL TIMES.

6. WHEN REQUIRED BY THE ISSUING OFFICE, THE PERMITTEE SHALL INSTALL A FLASHING ARROW SIGNAL AS SHOWN ON THE TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS.

7. ALL TRAFFIC LANES SHALL BE A MINIMUM OF 10 FEET WIDE.

8. ALL CONSTRUCTION WARNING SIGNS SHALL BE PROMPTLY REMOVED OR COVERED WHENEVER THE MESSAGE IS NOT APPLICABLE OR NOT IN USE.
9. THE BACKS OF ALL SIGNS USED FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL SHALL BE APPROPRIATELY COVERED TO PRECLUDE THE DISPLAY OF INAPPLICABLE SIGN MESSAGES (I.E., WHEN SIGNS HAVE MESSAGES ON BOTH FACES).

10. LANE CLOSURE SHALL BE LIMITED ONLY TO THE EXTENT OF ACCOMPLISHING EACH DAY'S WORK. AS SOON AS EACH DAY'S WORK IS COMPLETED, THE PERMITTEE SHALL REMOVE ALL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES NO LONGER NEEDED TO PERMIT FREE AND SAFE PASSAGE OF PUBLIC TRAFFIC. REMOVAL SHALL BE IN THE REVERSE ORDER OF INSTALLATION. 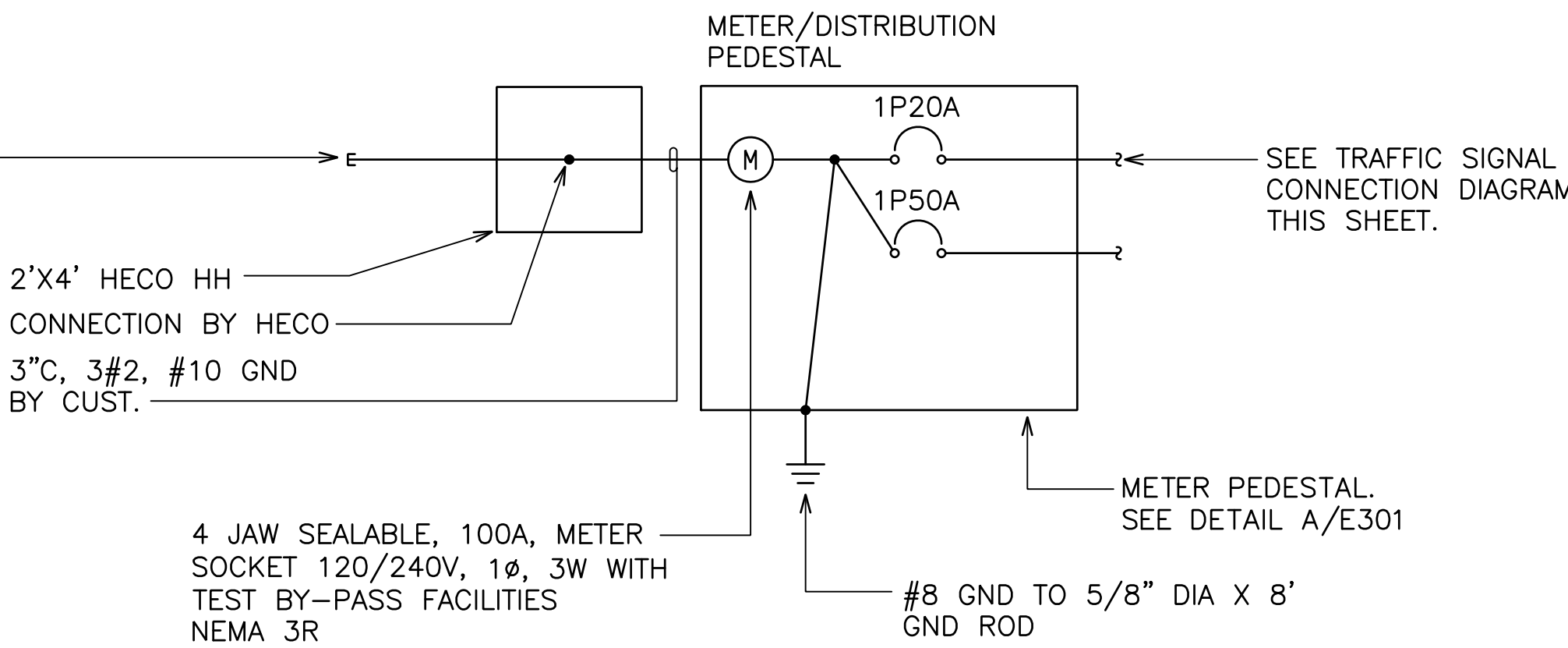

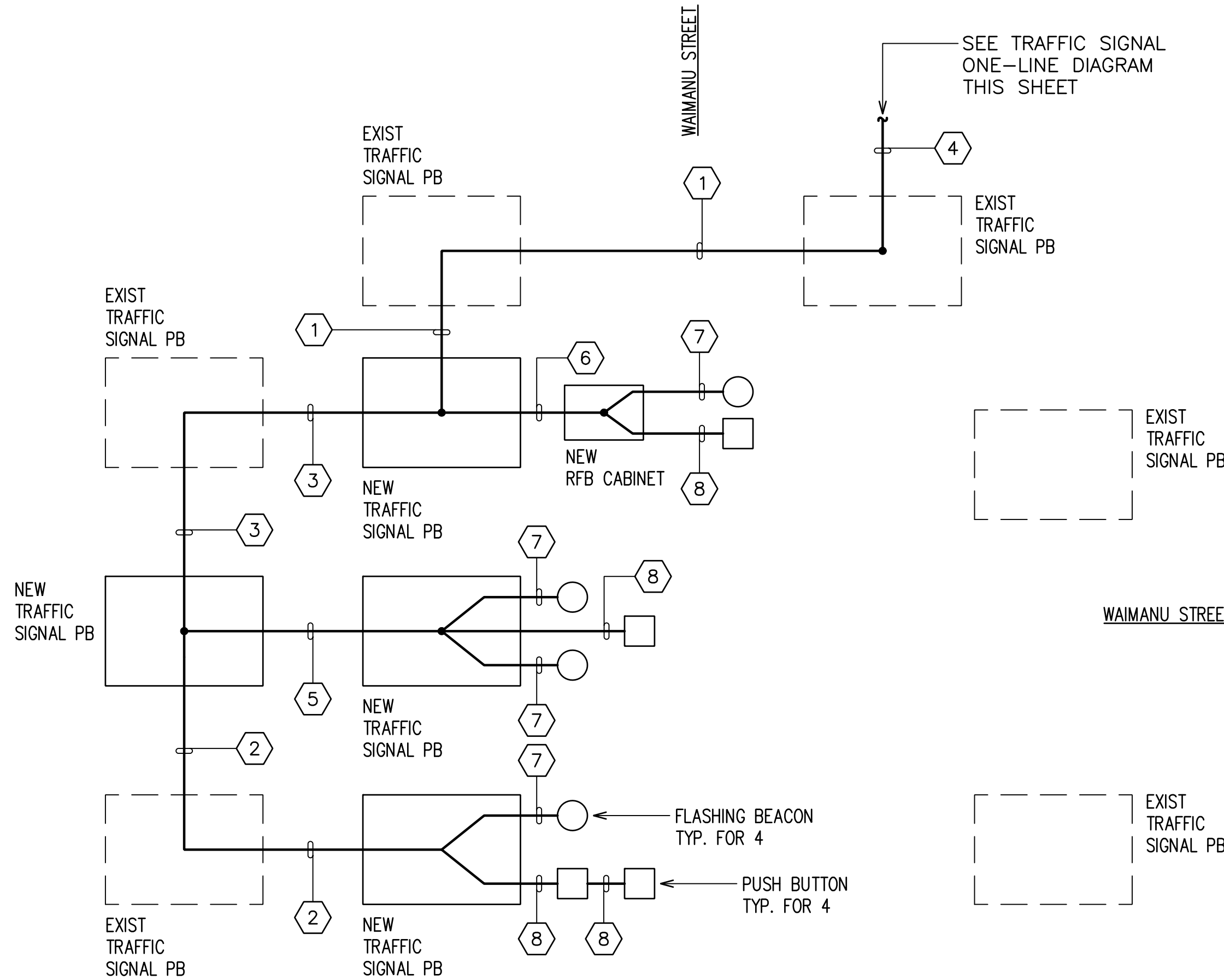
QUEEN STREET AND WAIMANU STREET

GENERAL NOTES

- A. CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY ALL FIELD DIMENSIONS AND CONDITIONS PRIOR TO STARTING WORK. DISCREPANCIES SHALL BE PROMPTLY REPORTED IN WRITING TO THE ENGINEER FOR RESOLUTION OR CLARIFICATION.
- B. OMISSIONS OR CONFLICTS BETWEEN THE VARIOUS ELEMENTS OF THE DRAWINGS AND/OR SPECIFICATIONS SHALL BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE ENGINEER BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH ANY WORK SO INVOLVED. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERECTING SAFETY BARRIERS, WARNING SIGNS, CONTROLLING TRAFFIC, AND ALL OTHER ISSUES RELATED TO JOBSITE SAFETY.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DESIGN AND PROVISION OF ALL FORM WORK, TEMPORARY BRACING, SHORING, ETC.

CONCRETE REPAIR NOTES:

1. CONCRETE REPAIR MATERIAL

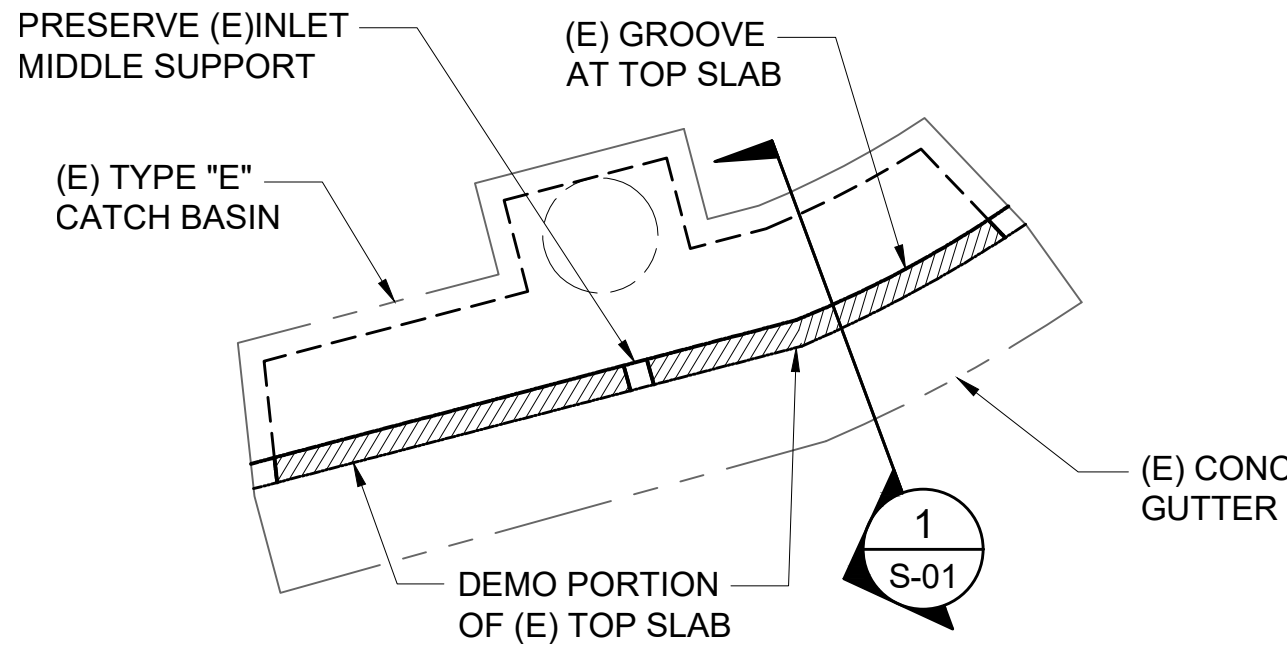
- A. USE PRODUCTS FOR CONCRETE SPALL REPAIR THAT ARE SPECIFICALLY DESIGNED FOR THE STRUCTURAL REPAIR OF DAMAGED CONCRETE. SUBMIT ALL PRODUCTS FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL PRIOR TO ORDERING MATERIAL.
- B. SUBMIT PRODUCT DATA, INCLUDING MANUFACTURER'S INSTRUCTIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS, FOR REVIEW BY THE ENGINEER PRIOR TO ORDERING MATERIAL.
- C. CONCRETE REPAIR MATERIAL SHALL BE A FACTORY BLENDED PATCHING MATERIAL CONTAINING LATEX POLYMER TYPE ADMIXTURE, SYNTHETIC FIBER AND CORROSION INHIBITOR, HAVING A MINIMUM COMPRESSIVE STRENGTH OF 5,000 PSI AT 28 DAYS AND MAXIMUM WATER/CEMENT RATIO OF 0.40.
- D. STRICTLY FOLLOW THE MANUFACTURER'S INSTRUCTIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE AMOUNT OF WATER TO BE ADDED.
- E. WHEN RECOMMENDED MY THE MANUFACTURER FOR LARGER REPAIRS, ADD AGGREGATE TO THE MIX. THE APPROPRIATE AGGREGATE SIZE SHALL BE SPECIFIED BY THE MANUFACTURER.
- F. AFTER MIXING, THE REPAIR MATERIAL SHALL HAVE THE APPROPRIATE WORKABILITY FOR PLACEMENT IN FORMS. SUPERPLASTICIZER ADMIXTURE SHALL NOT BE ADDED UNLESS SPECIFICALLY ALLOWED BY PATCHING MORTAR MANUFACTURER.

2. REINFORCING STEEL:

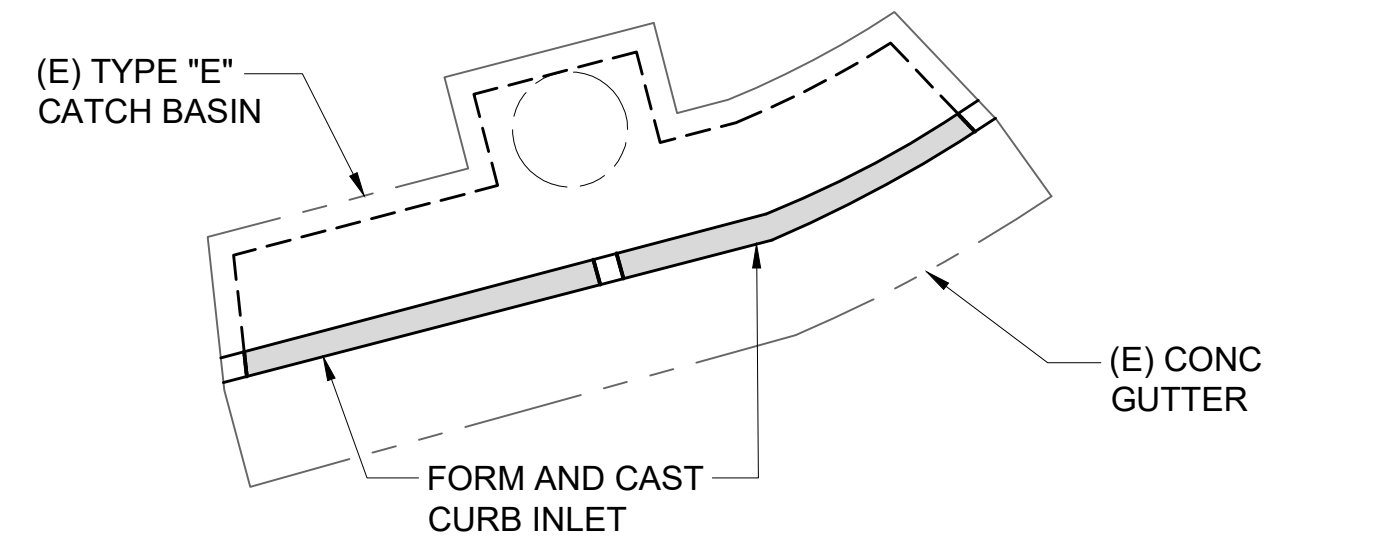
- A. STEEL REINFORCEMENT USED IN CONCRETE REPAIRS SHALL BE DEFORMED BAR CONFORMING TO ASTM A615 OR A706, GRADE 60.
- B. STEEL REINFORCEMENT SHALL BE FREE OF LOOSE RUST OR ANY SUBSTANCE THAT WILL INHIBIT BONDING WITH EPOXY OR CONCRETE REPAIR MATERIAL.

3. CONCRETE REPAIR PROCEDURE:

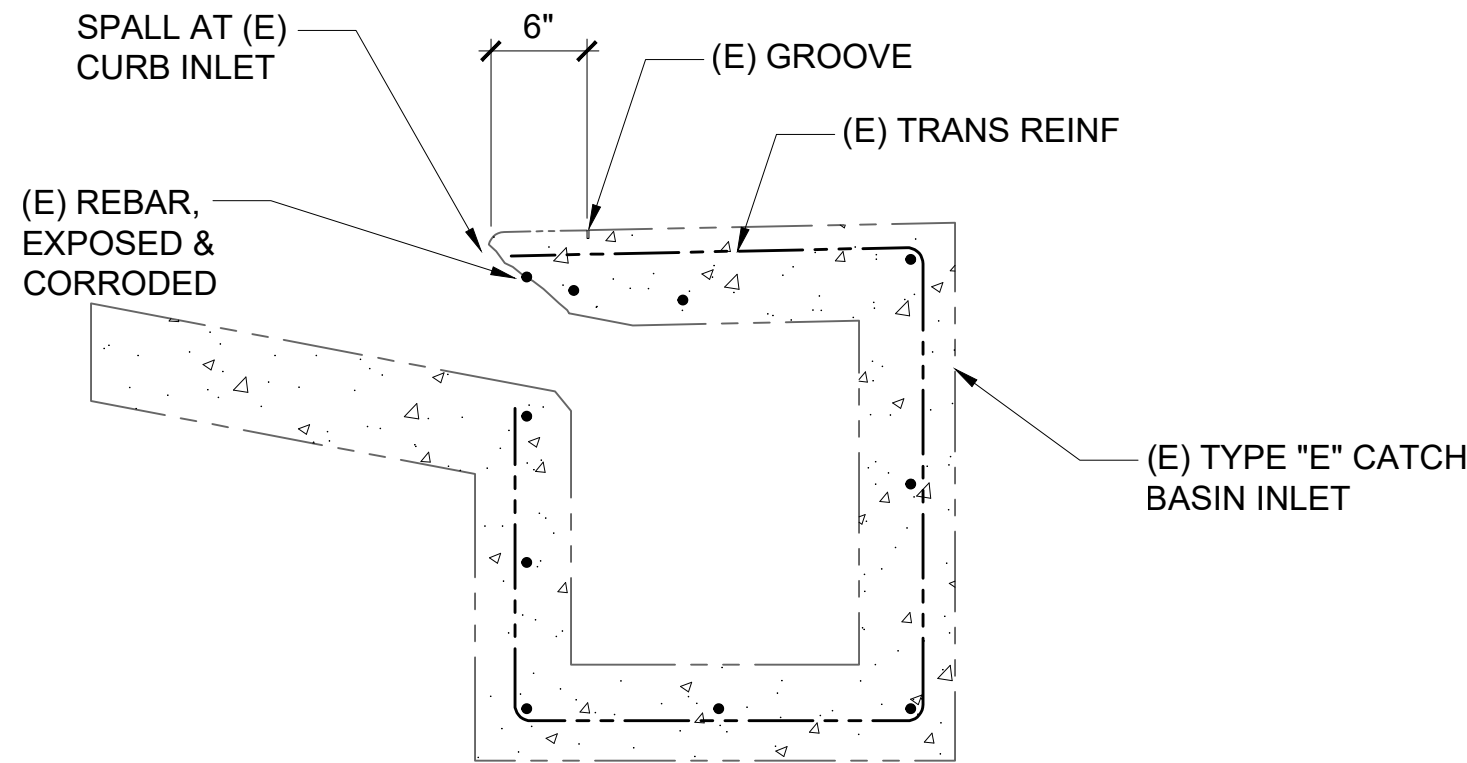
- A. CONTRACTOR SHALL USE MATERIAL SUPPLIERS AND EXPERIENCED PERSONNEL FAMILIAR IN CONCRETE REPAIR AND RESTORATION WORK. MANUFACTURER OF REPAIR PRODUCTS SHALL HAVE A REPRESENTATIVE IN HAWAII THAT CAN ADVISE AS TO THE PROPER USE OF THEIR PRODUCT.
- B. PRIOR TO STARTING ANY DEMOLITION WORK, PERFORM A VISUAL SURVEY THE TOP AND SOFFIT OF THE CATCH BASIN TOP SLAB. DELAMINATED OR SPALLED CONCRETE IN AREAS BEYOND WHAT IS SHOWN ON THE DEMOLITION PLAN, AND CRACKS IN THE CONCRETE WIDER THAN 0.03-INCH SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE ENGINEER. ADDITIONAL REPAIRS WILL ONLY BECOME A PART OF THE WORK UPON APPROVAL BY OWNER'S REPRESENTATIVE.
- C. ON-SITE OBSERVATION BY THE CONTRACTOR AND MATERIAL MANUFACTURER'S REPRESENTATIVE SHALL ALSO BE INCLUDED AS NEEDED. ANY REVISIONS OR RECOMMENDATIONS TO IMPROVE REPAIR MATERIALS OR METHODS SHALL BE SUBMITTED IN WRITING TO THE ENGINEER PRIOR TO STARTING THE WORK.
- D. BEFORE ANY DEMOLITION, CHIPPING, JACK HAMMERING, DRILLING, CORING, OR ANY OTHER DESTRUCTIVE REMOVAL WORK BEGINS, CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THAT THE OPERATION WILL NOT INJURE, OVERSTRESS, CRACK AND BREAK OR OTHERWISE DAMAGE EXISTING WORK TO REMAIN. PROVIDE SHORING, AS NEEDED, FOR THE SLAB PRIOR TO DEMOLITION WORK, AND LEAVE IN PLACE UNTIL REPAIR MATERIAL HAS PROPERLY CURED.
- E. ALL DAMAGED, DETERIORATED, LOOSENED (DELAMINATED), OR UNBONDED PORTIONS OF EXISTING CONCRETE UNTIL SOUND CONCRETE IS ENCOUNTERED. SOUND CONCRETE IS THE CONDITION WHERE THE EXPOSED SURFACE IS FIRMLY BONDED TO THE SURROUNDING CONCRETE AND DEVOID OF LOOSE PIECES, CRACKS, AND DELAMINATIONS (UNBONDED CONDITION BELOW THE SURFACE.) WHEN STRUCK WITH A HAMMER, SOUND CONCRETE WILL NOT PRODUCE A HOLLOW SOUND. IF A HOLLOW SOUND IS HEARD WHEN THE SURFACE IS STRUCK WITH A HAMMER, THE SURFACE CONCRETE IS NOT BONDED TO THE CONCRETE BELOW.
- F. CHIPPED OUT REPAIR AREA SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN $\frac{3}{4}$ INCH CLEAR BELOW, ABOVE, AND BEHIND ALL EXPOSED, CORRODED REINFORCING BAR.
- G. EDGES OF THE CHIPPED OUT AREA SHALL BE SAW CUT PERPENDICULAR TO THE CONCRETE SURFACE FOR A MINIMUM DEPTH OF AT LEAST $\frac{3}{4}$ INCH OR TO THE MINIMUM THICKNESS REPAIR MATERIAL MAY BE APPLIED, WHICHEVER IS GREATER. DO NOT SAW CUT THROUGH EXISTING REINFORCING BARS. DO NOT FEATHEREDGE THE REPAIR MATERIAL.
- H. EXPOSED EXISTING STEEL REINFORCEMENT SHALL BE CLEANED OF ALL SCALE, RUST, DIRT, OIL OR ANY OTHER DELETERIOUS MATERIAL.
- I. AFTER THE BAR HAS BEEN CLEANED BY HAND TOOLS OR WIRE BRUSH, MEASURE THE DIAMETER OF THE EXPOSED REINFORCING BARS AT THE EDGE OF THE CHIPPED OUT AREA. WHERE TRANSVERSE BARS HAVE DIAMETERS OF LESS THAN 7/16-INCH, ADD EPOXY DOWEL NEXT TO EXISTING LONGITUDINAL BAR. SEE TYPICAL DETAIL.
- J. IF NEEDED, MECHANICALLY ROUGHEN CONCRETE SURFACE TO PROMOTE BONDING OF THE REPAIR MATERIAL. THOROUGHLY CLEAN THE REPAIR ARE OF ALL DUST AND DEBRIS FROM THE CONCRETE AND STEEL SURFACES.
- K. FORM REPAIR AREA TO MATCH STANDARD CURB INLET SHOWN IN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, STANDARD DETAIL FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION.
- L. APPLY LATEX POLYMER BONDING AGENT TO SURFACE OF EXISTING CONCRETE PRIOR TO PLACING CONCRETE REPAIR MATERIAL. FOLLOW MANUFACTURER'S INSTRUCTIONS FOR SURFACE PREPARATION AND USAGE OF THE BONDING AGENT. APPLY CORROSION INHIBITOR SUCH AS "DURALPREP A.C. BY EUCLID CHEMICAL", "MCI 2022 BY CORTEC CORPORATION", OR "MAPEFER 1K BY MAPEI", DIRECTLY TO ALL REINFORCING PRIOR TO POURING OF CONCRETE. PLACE REPAIR MATERIAL WITHIN THE OPEN TIME OF THE BONDING AGENT.
- M. PLACE CONCRETE REPAIR MATERIAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH MANUFACTURER'S INSTRUCTIONS. CONSOLIDATE WITH MECHANICAL VIBRATION AS NEEDED TO CONSOLIDATE MATERIAL..
- N. FINISH SURFACE OF CONCRETE REPAIRS TO MATCH EXISTING SURFACE FINISH IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT TO REPAIR.
- O. FOLLOW MANUFACTURER'S INSTRUCTIONS FOR CURING OF THE REPAIR MATERIAL. PROTECT REPAIR FROM DAMAGE OR LOADING UNTIL THE MATERIAL HAS ACHIEVED IT'S DESIGN STRENGTH.
- P. CAREFULLY REMOVE FORMWORK TO THE SURFACE OF THE REPAIR. HONEYCOMBS OR OTHER SURFACE DEFECTS SHALL BE PATCHED PER THE MANUFACTURER'S INSTRUCTION.



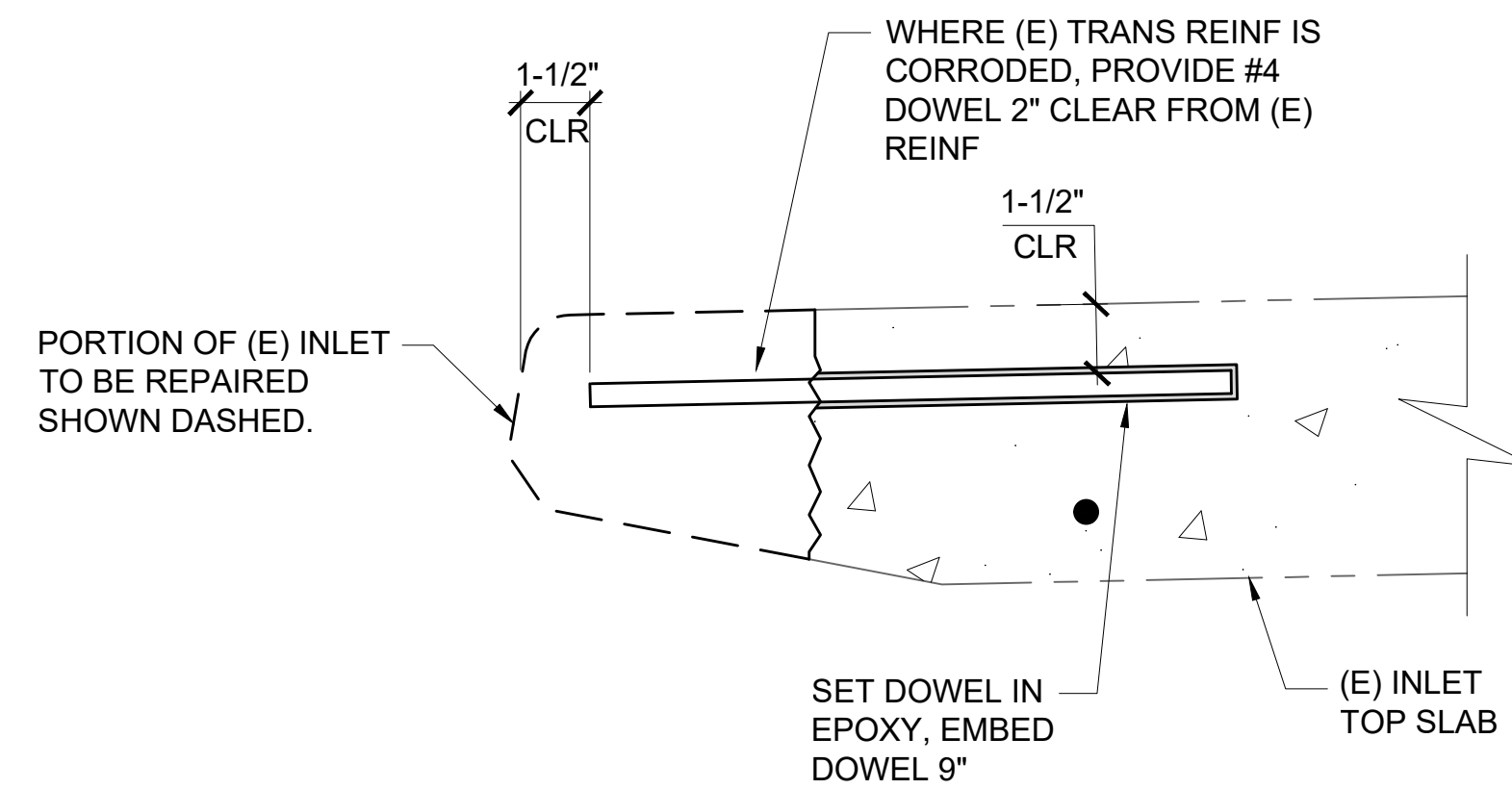
A EXISTING CATCH BASIN DEMO PLAN

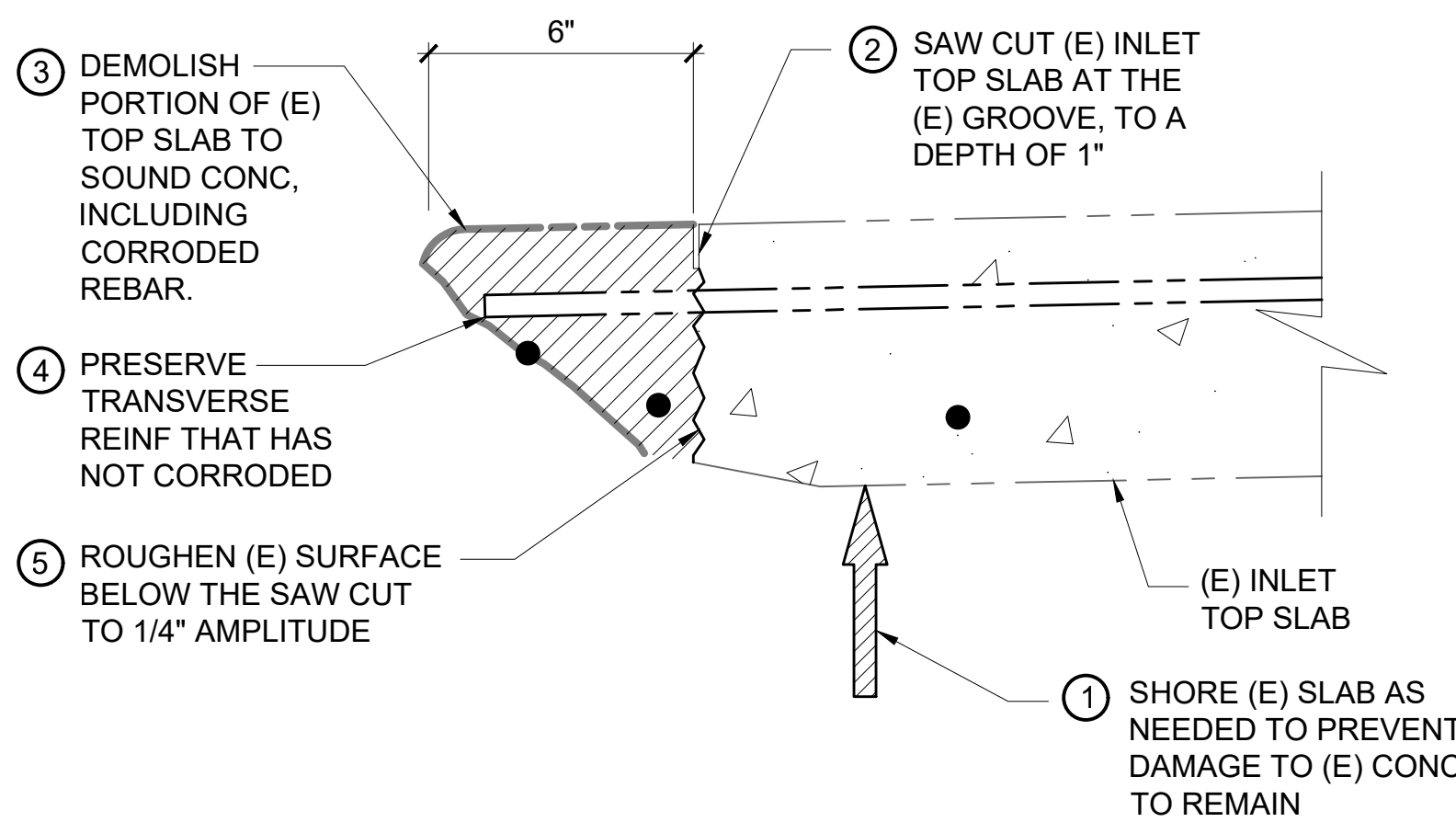
B EXISTING CATCH BASIN REPAIR PLAN

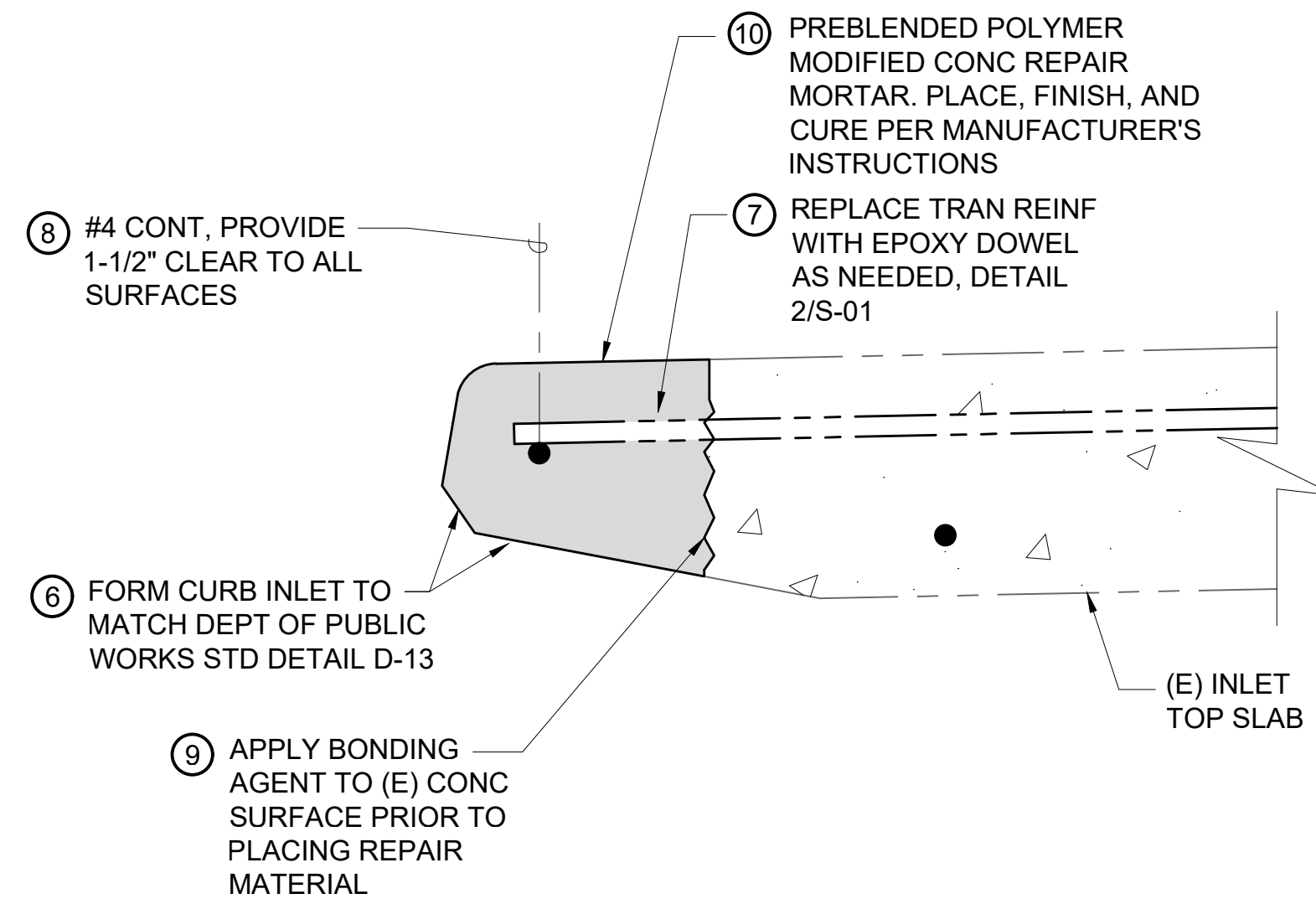
1 EXISTING DRAIN INLET SECTION

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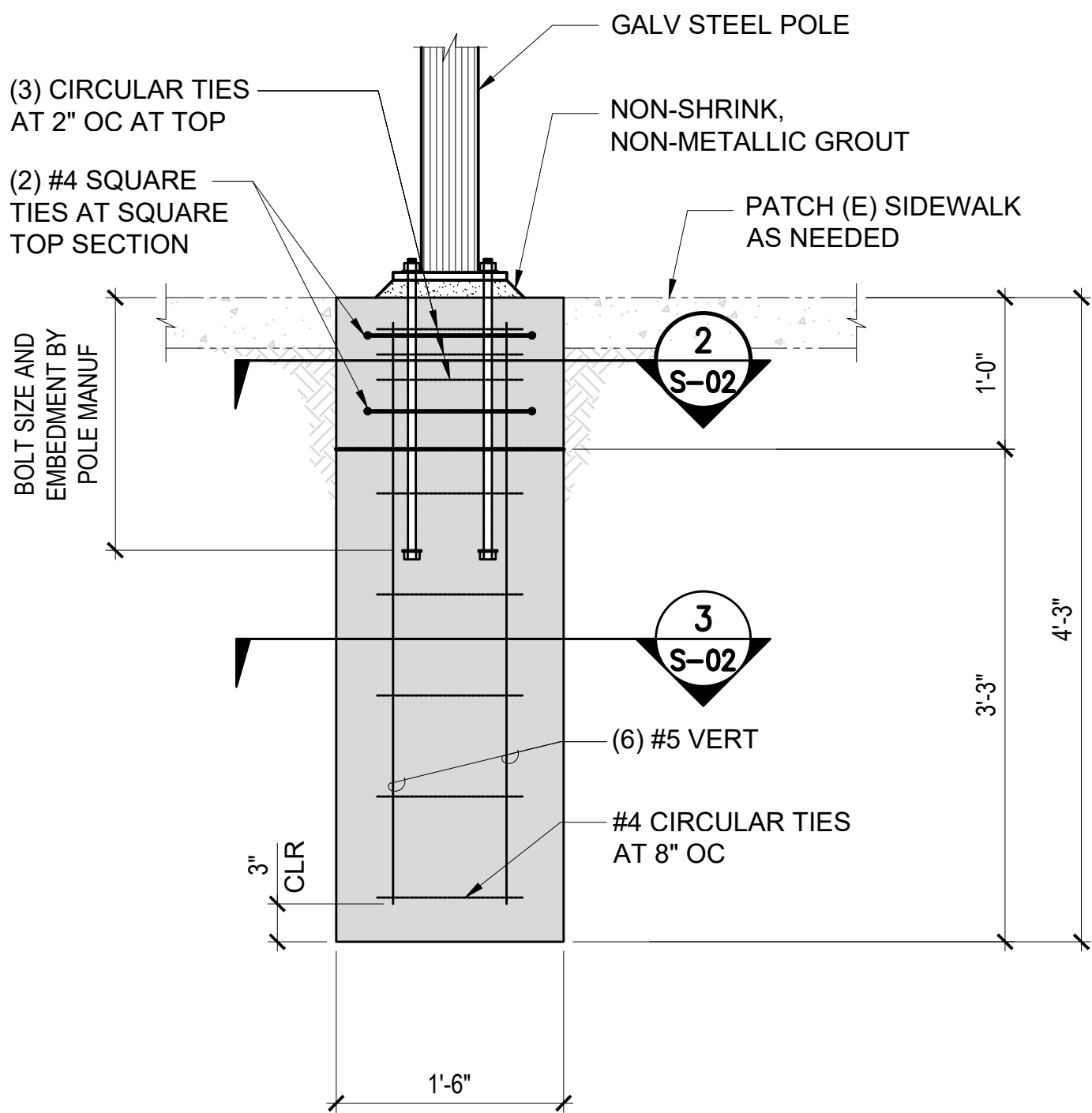

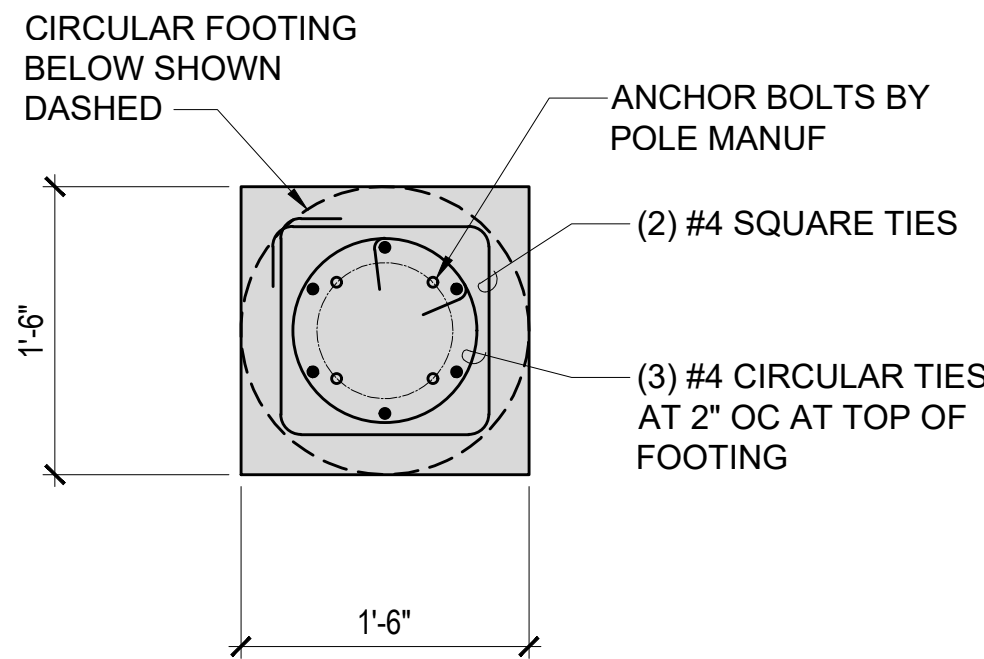
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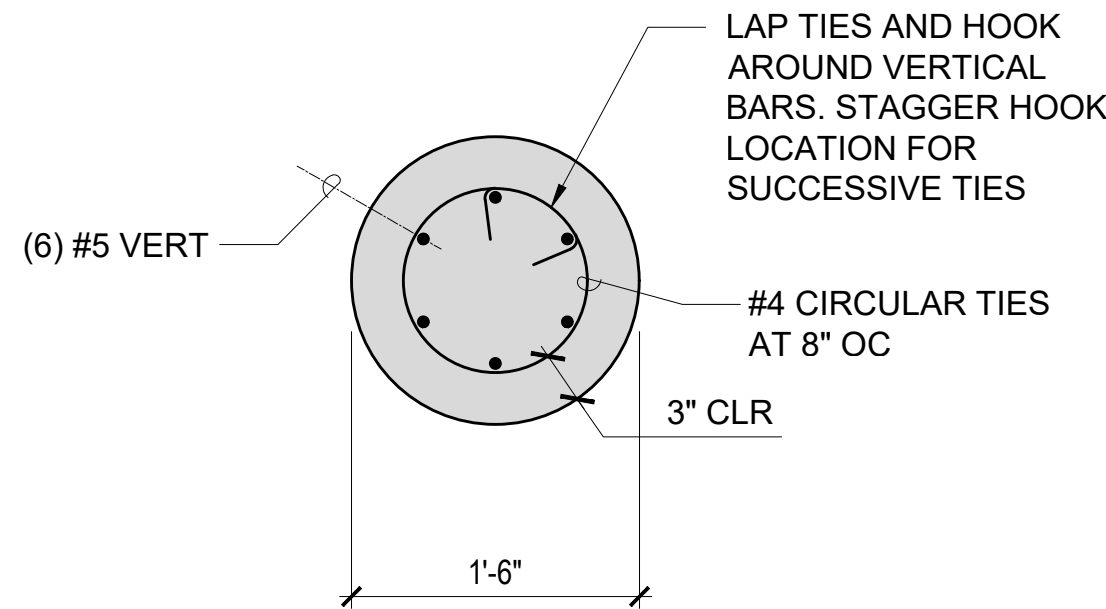

- B. REINFORCING STEEL SHALL BE DEFORMED BAR COMFORM TO ASTM A615, GRADE 60.
- C. SUBMIT CONCRETE MIX DESIGN FOR REVIEW BY THE ENGINEER PRIOR TO PLACING CONCRETE.
- D. PRIOR TO EXCAVATING FOR THE FOOTING OR FABRICATING THE REINFORCING STEEL, CONFIRM THAT THE ANCHOR BOLTS FOR THE POLE WILL BE INSIDE OF THE CIRCULAR TIES. NOTIFY THE ENGINEER IF THERE IS CONFLICT WITH THE ANCHOR BOLTS AND REINFORCING.
- E. EXCAVATE HOLE FOR FOOTING BY AUGER. IF GROUND WATER IS ENCOUNTERED, PROVIDE A SLEEVE TO MAINTAIN THE SIDES OF THE EXCAVATION. USE TERMIE METHOD TO PLACE CONCRETE AND SLOWLY WITHDRAWN SLEEVE DURING CONCRETE PLACEMENT.
