OBJECTIVE

To obtain one (1) ELECTRIC ORDER PICKER AND CHARGER for delivery at the Foreign-Trade Zone (FTZ) No.9, located at 521 Ala Moana Boulevard, Pier 2, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, within four (4) months.

- 1. The CONTRACTOR shall deliver one (1) 3,000 pound order picker, as described below:
 - a. Model Year: 2023 Or Newer
 - b. Odometer Reading: Less Than 25 Hours
 - c. Power Type: Battery, 36v, 750 ampere hours capacity, with watering system and watering monitor sensor and light indicator
 - d. Capacity: 3,000 LB Minimum
 - e. Mast: 95" Collapsed / 210" Overall lift height / 144" lift limit with bypass switch
 - f. Other
 - i. Side gates with power disconnect switches
 - ii. 5" pallet clamp jaw
 - iii. Reverse travel alarm
 - iv. LED compartment and work area lights
 - v. Full body harness with retractable tether
 - vi. Cold storage conditioning
 - vii. Clipboard
- 2. The CONTRACTOR shall deliver one (1) charger, as described below:
 - a. Wall Mountable, 480v, 3-Phase
 - b. Plug: One (1) Six (6) Foot Minimum
- 3. Warranties
 - i. 12 Months or 2000 Hours Manufacturer's Warranty
 - ii. 36 Months or 6000 Hours Powertrain Warranty
- 4. Delivery: Foreign-Trade Zone, 521 Ala Moana Blvd., Honolulu, HI 96813
- 5. Maintenance Covering 36-Month Warranty Period
 - a. Maintenance shall be carried out by factory-certified maintenance technicians.
 - b. The CONTRACTOR shall provide all labor, tools, equipment, materials, supplies, supervision, and all other items to repair and maintain the electric forklifts and chargers in accordance with the manufacturer's maintenance schedule, and all terms and provisions of its warranty and this solicitation.

- c. The CONTRACTOR shall ensure that the equipment is properly adjusted and use all reasonable care to maintain the order picker in proper and safe operating condition in compliance with any and all state, federal, and city and county laws, ordinances, and regulations.
- d. The CONTRACTOR shall ensure that equipment passes all safety inspections.

TERM OF CONTRACT

1. Term of Contract

CONTRACTOR shall deliver the goods described herein within four (4) months of the start date on the Notice to Proceed.

The services by the CONTRACTOR described herein shall commence upon receipt of the order picker. The Contract shall be completed within thirty-six (36) months of the receipt date, unless sooner terminated as hereinafter provided.
