
NOTICE TO BIDDERS

SEALED BIDS for MAINTENANCE OF VIDEO MONITORING AND ACCESS CONTROL SYSTEM (VMACS), ELLISON ONIZUKA KONA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AT KEAHOLE, KAILUA-KONA, HAWAII, PROJECT NO. BH2421-53 will begin as advertised on HiePRO. Bidders are to register and submit bids through HiePRO only. Deadline to submit bids is August 30, 2023, at 2:00 p.m., Hawaii Standard Time (HST). The complete bid Proposal Schedule shall be uploaded into HiePRO prior to bid opening date and time. All other confidential and proprietary documents shall be uploaded separately. **Failure to upload the bid Proposal Schedule into HiePRO shall be grounds for rejection of the bid.** Bids received after the said due date and time shall not be considered.

The scope of work consists of providing technical expertise, labor, material, taxes, insurance, overhead, travel and incidental costs necessary to service, maintain, and repair all equipment associated with the VMACS, as well as its subsystems, assemblies, subassemblies, communication network and associated components, at Ellison Onizuka Kona International Airport at Keahole.

To be eligible for award, bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii Specialty Contractor's "C-13" or "C-15" License at the time of bid opening.

 A one-time site visit will be scheduled on August 25, 2023, at 10:00 a.m., HST. Interested bidders are to report to the Airport Manager's Office. All prospective bidders or their representatives (employees) are encouraged to attend the site visit, but attendance is not mandatory.

All questions and substitution requests shall be received in writing submitted via HiePRO no later than fourteen (14) calendar days before the bid opening date. Request For Information (RFI) Questions received after the deadline will not be addressed. Verbal RFIs will not receive a response.

Campaign contributions by State and County Contractors. Contractors are hereby notified of the applicability of Section 11-355, HRS, which states that campaign contributions are prohibited from

specified State or county government contractors during the term of the contract if the contractors are paid with funds appropriated by a legislative body. For more information, contact the Campaign Spending Commission at (808) 586-0285.

Protests. Any protest of this solicitation shall be submitted in writing to the Director of Transportation, in accordance with §103D-701, HRS and §3-126, HAR.
