1. Question: **Can we get a Break Down of the Vehicle: VIN, Year, Make, Model and Engine/Transmission?**

Response: There is no complete list of State Airport vehicles with Vehicle Identification Number (VIN), Year, Make, Model and Engine/Transmission. See Section 10.3.A of Bid Specifications for a general description of Airport fleet size, types of vehicle make and models.

2. Question: **How are the vehicles getting to the repair facility from the Airport? Are we responsible for pick up and delivery or is the Airport bringing the vehicles to us?**

Response: The State Automotive Shop manager shall identify on Work Order issued to the contractor who will transfer vehicles to repair shop. If towing is needed, see Bid Specifications Section 10.4.D regarding specialty services.

3. Question: **There is no mention of parts in the RFP. How are the parts going to be acquired for the repairs?**

Response: See Section 10.3.B of Bid Specifications. State Project Manager or Automotive Shop manager shall issue a work order. The Contractor shall return work order with estimate to perform work including labor and parts. Then, State will issue a purchase order for the particular work order.

4. Question: **There is no mention of parts in the RFP. How are the parts going to be acquired for the repairs?**

Response: See Question 3 response.

5. Question: **Is the work scheduled or is it as needed?**

Response: See Section 10.3.A of Bid Specifications. Contractor will provide services on an “as needed” basis.

6. Question: **How many vehicles need to be worked on at a time?**

Response: See Section 10.3.A of Bid Specifications. Contractor will provide services on an “as needed” basis. Number of vehicles to be worked on will vary.
