- Spaceworx Decibel Single XL acoustical office phone booth, with the following options
 - o White powder coated steel frame
 - White side panels
 - Quietworx Upholstery Walls (color to be specified upon award)
 - Data port
 - FireShield Fire Suppression
 - ADA Ramp
 - No sidelights in back wall; back wall and both side walls should be solid acoustical panels
 - Freight to Hawai'i assembly/installation not required

NOTE: Price is to be inclusive of shipping, delivery to facility, tax, and standard factory warranty.

Qualifications:

All Offerors responding to this solicitation **must be** HCE compliant with the State at time of award.

Special Terms and Conditions:

- a. <u>SOH General Conditions</u>: General Conditions issued by the Department of the Attorney General of SOH, referred to as Form AG-008, as revised, are included in this HiePRO solicitation by reference. The applicable revised Form AG-008, which is included by reference, is the form dated and in effect at the date the solicitation is issued.
- b. <u>Compliance Pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) §103D-310(c)</u>: Pursuant to HRS section 103D-310(c) and HAR section 3-122-112, the successful vendor is required to provide proof of compliance and may use the Hawaii Compliance Express for all contracts awarded (see https://vendors.ehawaii.gov/hce/splash/welcome.html). Please note: obtaining proof of

compliance can take multiple weeks; SOH HSA cannot make an award to a non-compliant vendor.

c. <u>Basis of Award</u>: Award is based on Best Value. When the award to the lowest responsive, responsible offeror is not practicable, award shall be made to the offeror whose quote provides the best value to the State. "Best Value" means the most advantageous offer determined by evaluating and comparing all relevant criteria in addition to price so that the offer meeting the overall combination that best services HSA, is selected. Criteria may include, but not limited to, the total cost of ownership, performance history of the vendor, quality of goods, services, delivery and proposed technical performance.
