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VESSEL REGISTRATION & TITLING FEES AS OF 3/20/2021

Registration Renewal Fees (Charged Annually):

Registration renewal for vessels under 20'.....	\$20.00
Registration renewal for vessels 20' and longer.....	\$35.00
State boat launch ramp use.....	\$75.00

Replacement Fees (Charged Each Time):

Replacement registration card (includes registration decals).....	\$10.00
Replacement ramp decals.....	\$10.00

Late Fees (In Addition to Any Charges Above):

Late registration renewal fee for vessels under 20'.....	\$20.00
Late registration renewal fee for vessels 20' and longer.....	\$35.00

Please note that DOBOR only handles registration and titling of vessels. Registration of vessel trailers is handled by County DMV offices. Vessel trailer safety inspections can be performed by the same types of stations that perform vehicle safety inspections.

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IMPORTANT NOTES

1. Never operate a boat under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
 2. The owner must notify DOBOR in writing (mail or email) within five (5) business days if the vessel is documented with DOBOR lost, destroyed, abandoned, or sunk.
 3. The owner must notify DOBOR in writing (mail or email) within five (5) business days if the owner's address changes. New owners also required to reflect address change.
 4. Unless exempt, all persons operating a motorized vessel must have passed an approved boating safety course (HAR § 13-242-15.5).
 5. Vessel grounding insurance required unless otherwise exempt (HAR § 200-13.5).
 6. The operator of a vessel involved in a boating accident must:
 - a. Stop and render aid; and
 - b. Report any accident resulting in loss of life or disappearance of any person on the vessel, medical treatment beyond first aid, or damage to any vessel or property in excess of \$2,000.00 (HAR § 13-242-4). Forms available at DOBOR offices.
