Pelekunu Molokai Archeological Field Inspection 2024

This addendum answers questions regarding this project:

- Q. I am inquiring about the Pelekunu Moloka'i Archaeological Field Inspection specifications outlined in the Attachment A-Scope of Work. It is indicated that sections of the corridor are inaccessible and will not require field inspection. To ensure that aspects of our proposal submission accurately reflect the needs of the project, could you provide an estimate of the proposed 3.1-mile corridor that will not require field survey? We would also appreciate information regarding which areas of the proposed project area would be inaccessible, as planning an alternate pathway to complete field inspections of all accessible areas would also need to be considered. Thank you in advance for your time.
- A. It is estimated that 40% of the entire fenceline is inaccessible and will not need to be surveyed. The inaccessible sections are generally on the ends of the fenceline where they rise up steep ridges, so many sections do not need to have alternate pathways to get to them. Staff will be available to accompany the archaeologist and provide ways to access all the sections of the fenceline that require surveys.
