## **SPECIFICATIONS**

- 3. <u>Land Clearing and Solid Waste Removal, TMK 7-1-002:037 and 7-1-002:044 52 Acres.</u>
  - A. Contractor shall clear approximately 52 acres identified as TMKs 7-1-002:037 and 7-1-002:044. This includes removing all grass, trees, and shrubs entirely. Tree stumps shall be ground 6-12 inches below grade with a stump grinder, or equivalent.
  - B. Contractor shall be responsible for clearing any vegetation and/or moving obstructions, such as boulders or logs to get their workers and equipment to the subject area.
  - C. The associated green waste from cutting and grinding shall be finely chipped (3 inches or less) and dispersed evenly on site (on ADC property) where they will rot and decompose. Any green waste that cannot be chipped on site to specification (3 inches or less) shall be hauled away by the contractor to a permitted green waste facility.
  - D. Significant soil disturbance should not occur. All land and vegetative clearing must be conducted in a way that minimizes the movement of soil. Extensive grading and grubbing in not permitted.
  - E. The Contractor shall leave the property in a clean and neat condition.
  - F. All work shall be done in a manner consistent with industry standards and in compliance with all federal, state, and county laws.

## Solid Waste Removal.

- G. Contractor shall remove all solid waste located within the subject area.
- H. Contractor shall be responsible for removing and disposing of the solid waste.
- I. Arrangements shall be made with a licensed landfill operator or recycling operator.
- J. All work shall be done in a manner consistent with industry standards and in compliance with all federal, state, and county laws.
