Bidders shall not include confidential and/or proprietary documents as part of their proposal. The scope of work consists of repairing light poles at Piers 1 and 2 at Kahului Harbor, Maui, Hawaii. The estimated cost of construction is between \$2,000,000 and \$3,000,000.

To be eligible for award, bidders shall possess a valid State of Hawaii General Engineering Contractor's "A" or Specialty Contractor's "C-13" license <u>at the time of bidding.</u> The Hawaii Department of Transportation, Air and Water Transportation Facilities Division, 2016 GENERAL PROVISIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS, applicable to this project are available on the internet at: <u>http://hidot.hawaii.gov/administration/con/</u>.

A virtual pre-bid conference is scheduled for <u>November 22, 2024 at 9:00 a.m., HST</u>. All prospective bidders and/or their respective representatives are encouraged to attend, however, attendance is not mandatory. All information presented at the pre-bid conference shall be provided for clarification and information only. Any amendments to the solicitation shall be made by formal addendum and posted in HIePRO.

All Request for Information (RFI) questions and Substitution Requests shall be submitted in HIePRO <u>no later than December 2, 2024 at 2:00 p.m., HST</u>. RFI questions received after the stated deadline shall not be addressed. Substitution Requests received after the stated deadline shall not be considered. Verbal RFI(s) shall not receive a response. All responses to RFI questions shall be provided for clarification and information only and issued by formal addendum. Any amendments to the solicitation shall be made by formal addendum and posted in HIePRO.

<u>Apprenticeship Preference</u>. A five percent bid adjustment for bidders that are party to apprenticeship agreements pursuant to HRS § 103-55.6 is applicable to this project.

Employment of State Residents on Construction Procurement Contracts. Compliance with HRS § 103B-3 is a requirement for this project whereby a minimum of 80 percent of the bidder's work force on this project shall consist of Hawaii residents.

I. <u>INTRODUCTION</u>

II. <u>IMPORTANT ITEMS</u>

- 1. This meeting is to clarify general questions only. If there is a conflict between what was stated in this meeting and the bid documents, the bid documents shall govern. Any significant changes will be issued through an addendum. A copy of the meeting minutes will be issued to all attendees.
- 2. Deadline for questions and RFIs is on December 2, 2024 at 2:00 p.m., HST. All questions must be submitted through HIePRO.
- 3. Proposals Due on December 19, 2024, at 2:00 p.m., HST.
- 4. The scope of work consists of repairing light poles at Piers 1 and 2 at Kahului Harbor, Maui, Hawaii.
- 5. The estimated cost is between \$2,000,000 to \$3,000,000.
- 6. Key Information
 - a. Bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii General Engineering Contractor's "A" license at the time of bidding.

III. <u>GENERAL DISCUSSIONS</u>

1. Question: What are the security requirements for the project?

Response: See Article 10, section 10.11, of the specifications.

2. Question: Who is responsible for installing the nodes connecting to the existing wireless GE light control system?

Response: The nodes will be installed by the Contractor, who will have to coordinate with Harbors to connect to the existing system.

3. Question: Is there a preferred manufacturer for poles and light fixtures? Is light testing required?

Response: See sheets E-11 to E-13 of the contract drawings for light fixture requirements. The pole provided shall meet the requirements shown on the contract drawings (see sheets E-11 to E-13). See Article 14, section 14.5, of the specifications for testing requirements.

4. Question: Will security cameras need to be reinstalled and can the conduits be placed inside the pole?

Response: Cameras shall be reinstalled by the Contractor, as per sheets E-10 and E-13 of the contract drawings. For the purpose of bidding, assume reinstalled items will match existing.

5. Question: Will current pole foundations be replaced?

Response: At Pier 1, existing foundations will be reused and pedestals replaced to accommodate pole anchors. At Pier 2, new foundations and pedestals will be installed.
