

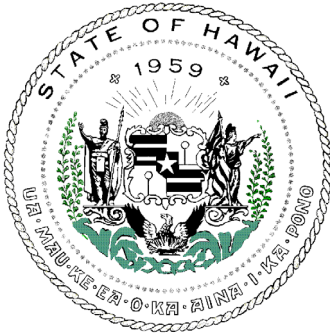

1.4 Contract Type

This solicitation will result in a fixed-price contract in accordance with section 3-122-136, Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR).

1.5 Period of Performance

The contract shall be for a period of 24 months beginning on the date specified in the Notice to Proceed. Unless terminated, the contract may be extended without re-solicitation, upon mutual agreement in writing between the State and the Contractor, prior to the expiration date, for not more than three (3) additional 12-month periods, or parts thereof. The entire term of contract, including extensions, shall not exceed 60 months.

1.6 Point of Contact

The State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation, Highways is the issuing agency for this document and all subsequent addenda relating to it.
