1. Do you have a complete tree inventory for all areas within the contract limits so bidders can accurately quantify their proposals? We want to ensure all companies are bidding on the same quantities and specific trees to maintain consistency and fairness in the evaluation process. Please provide the inventory, maps, or tree list identifying the exact trees included in the scope.

Prospective bidders shall be responsible for reviewing work areas to determine existing inventory, work conditions and work requirements.

2. For the areas NOT-IN-CONTRACT (area 6, 10 & 13), are we submitting a price for tree service in the proposal for those areas? OR do those areas not require tree service and do not need to be in the proposal?

Areas 6,10, and 13 do not require tree service and do not need to be in the proposal.

3. This contract is a three year base + 2 option years. However, the quote only has line items for unit prices and year 1 totals. Should those 1 year prices reflect pricing for the average of the three year base and/or include the 2 option years. Or should we have a separate attachment for option years?

Contract proposal is for 12 months (one year) of work. Renewal to extend contract will be based upon the original proposal prices. There will be no adjustment in prices allowed per Section 10.15C of the Specifications.

4. Do you have or can you provide an inventory tree count by tree types for each location?

Prospective bidders shall be responsible for reviewing work areas to determine existing inventory, work conditions and work requirements.

5. Just to 100% confirm, when submitting the final quote amount on Hawaii.gov, we should include the \$100K (line item 35) for the additional allowance as directed?

The Total Amount for Comparison of Bids should include all items 1 to 35.
