

Amendment 7: Continuation of Proposed Exceptions

Reference: RFP – Attachment 3 Proposed Exceptions; Attachment 9 State of Hawaii General Conditions; Attachment 10 State of Hawaii Supplemental General Conditions

The State has carefully reviewed each of the Offeror's proposed exceptions and has addressed each exception in the State's written responses provided with this Amendment 7. Going forward, the State is requesting each Offeror to respond to each of the State's written responses with more certain, exact, and detailed terms (if the term remains an issue). Unprotected, editable versions of Attachment 9, the State of Hawaii General Conditions, and Attachment 10, the State of Hawaii Supplemental General Conditions, are included as part of this Amendment 7 for Offeror's use.

The State acknowledges the Offeror's intent to rely upon Offeror's stand-alone documents such as a SaaS, licensing, or subscription agreement, to govern a resulting contract, and welcomes the Offeror to incorporate language from its stand-alone document into the State's General Conditions and Supplemental General Conditions, where necessary. The State expects Offeror to explain in the Change Log, using the same numbering system as the State's written responses, and in detail satisfactory to the State, the reason why the Offeror's terms may be more suitable to both the State and the Offeror. Absent explicit reasons satisfactory to the State, it is the State's intent that most, if not all, of the State's General Conditions and Supplemental General Conditions shall govern, with reasonable amendments.

It is the State's intent to receive red-lined versions of the State's General Conditions and Supplemental General Conditions, showing additions by underline and deletions by strike-through; and to receive a Change Log using the identification numbers (ID#) provided by the State in the State's written response. Offerors shall not modify existing ID numbers or introduce new ID numbers. General comments, summaries, or statements of intent are highly discouraged.
