The following notes are from the Hawaii Department of Transportation (HDOT) pre-bid meeting with prospective bidders for Project No. HWY-O-04-26, Erosion Control and Best Management Practices for Storm Water Permit Compliance, Phase IV, Oahu, District of Koolaupoko, Island of Oahu.

The meeting was conducted virtually via Zoom at 9:00 am Hawaii Standard Time.

All attendees were notified of the following:

- This meeting is being recorded. The recording will not be part of the addendum.
- Anything said at this meeting is for clarification only. The bid documents shall govern over anything said today and discrepancies shall be clarified by addendum.
- Scope of Work for this project consists of preparing slope surfaces; clearing vegetation; recontouring existing slopes; planting; hydro-mulching; installation of erosion control matting; installation and maintenance of temporary BMPs and providing traffic control.
- Point Identification Number (PID 207) is located along the right shoulder of H-3, Honolulu bound direction, prior to Exit 11 to Kamehameha Highway. (Location Plan on Sheet No. 3)
- PID 416 is located along right shoulder of Kamehameha Highway, Kaneohe bound direction, adjacent to Hawaiian Memorial Park and Cemetery. (Location Plan on Sheet No. 3)

1. Is there a pre-bid meeting attendees list?

Pre-Bid meeting attendees are listed in the Pre-Bid Meeting Minutes included in Addendum No. 1.

2. Are you requiring union labor for this project, or can both union and non-union contractors participate?

There are no restrictions on union and non-union contractors.

3. Can work be performed at both sites at the same time? Or does one have to be completed before starting on the next?

There are no restrictions in the specifications for working on both sites at the same time.

4. Is there grading work to be performed on this project?

Yes, there is grading work involved for PID 416. No anticipated grading work for PID 207.

5. To meet the lines and grades shown on the drawings, will all requirements of Section 203 – Excavation and Embankment apply in their entirety, including provisions such as: “When embankment is required on existing slopes steeper than five horizontal to one vertical, bench those areas as work is brought up in layers”? We are concerned that benching the existing slope may conflict with or disturb the existing root structure.

All requirements of Specification Section 203 – Excavation and Embankment must be met.

6. Please provide applicable pay items for excavation and embankment.

See Proposal Schedule pay items 203.2100 and 203.2200.

7. What permits are required for this project besides the one shown on plan sheet 8?

A grading permit is also required per plan sheet 19.

8. What are the working hours, Monday to Friday, 7:00am to 3:30pm?

Working hours are Monday to Friday, 7:00 am to 3:30 pm.

9. What is the total hours for the traffic control/lane closure in the work zone areas, 8:30am to 3:00pm?

Traffic control/lane closures in work areas are 8:30 am to 3:00 pm, Monday to Friday per Specification Section 645.

10. Can we do traffic control/lane closure in weekends or holidays?

Traffic control/lane closure may not occur on weekends or holidays per Specification Section 645.
