**RESPONSES TO REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION (RFI'S/ QUESTIONS)**

The following Requests for Information (RFI) were received.

**1. Question: How many badges in CCURE?**

Response: The exact number varies but there are approximately 4,500 active badges at Lihue Airport.

**2. Question: What licenses need to be renewed and when?**

Response: Refer to Attachment A of the Specifications for listing of licenses. Software House C•CURE 9000 SSA expires February 2027, Genetec Security Center Advantage Plan expires February 2027, and Cisco Advantage expires June 2030.

**3. Question: How many A/B doors?**

Response: Approximately 100 A/B doors including perimeter gates.

**4. Question: Can we have access to OT tickets for the year prior to bid due date?**

Response: Trouble call records are available for public inspection at Lihue Airport.

**5. Question: Can we have access to the last 4 quarterly reports prior to bid due date?**

Response: Reports are available for public inspection at Lihue Airport.

**6. Question: How many Cameras are currently down?**

Response: There are 28 cameras down and under repair.

**7. Question: Is there a space to securely keep spare parts and tools onsite?**

Response: Refer to Section 10.4 Provisions for Field Office/Storage Space. There is no space currently used for storage of VMACS maintenance spare parts or tools at Lihue Airport.

**8. Question: Is it possible to keep a vehicle on the AOA for maintenance and transportation around the airport property?**

Response: Permission to keep a vehicle in the Air Operations Area would depend on the size/type of vehicle being proposed, the current maintenance contractor parks a golf cart type vehicle in the baggage handling area of Lihue Airport.

**9. Question: Can a site visit be arranged prior to the bid due date?**
