2. It has not been assisted or represented on this matter by any individual who has, in a State capacity, been involved in the subject matter of this contract within the past two years.
3. It has not and will not, either directly or indirectly offered or given a gratuity (i.e. an entertainment or gift) to any State or County employee to obtain a contract or favorable treatment under a contract.

The undersigned Bidder further agrees to the following:

1. If this proposal is accepted, it shall execute a contract with the Department to provide all necessary labor, machinery, tools, equipment, apparatus and any other means of construction, to do all the work and to furnish all the materials specified in the contract in the manner and within the time therein prescribed in the contract, and that it shall accept in full payment therefore the sum of the unit and/or lump sum prices as set forth in the attached proposal schedule for the actual quantities of work performed and materials furnished and furnish satisfactory security in accordance with Section 103D-324, Hawaii Revised Statutes, within 10 days after the award of the contract or within such time as the Director of Transportation may allow after the undersigned has received the contract documents for execution, and is fully aware that non-compliance with the aforementioned terms will result in the forfeiture of the full amount of the bid guarantee required under Section 103D-323, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

The following Requests for Information (RFI) were received:

1. **QUESTION:** Will the handling and disposal of slurry generated from sawcut grooves be paid for by Items 1561 or 1562?

RESPONSE: No. Handling and disposal of sawcut groove slurry should be considered incidental to the associated saw cutting/grooving operation and is not separately compensated under Items 01561 or 01562.

2. **QUESTION:** Will the installation, maintenance and removal for staging area BMPs be paid for by Items 1561 or 1562?

RESPONSE: Yes. Installation, maintenance, and removal of BMPs associated with contractor staging areas are considered part of Item 01561.1, Construction Site Pollution Controls. Compensation for staging area BMPs would be included under Item 01561.1 and would not be paid under Item 01562.
