REFUSE COLLECTION – NORTH KONA DISTRICT
SPECIFICATIONS**

Revised per Addendum No. 1 dated August 14, 2026

JOB LOCATIONS: HONOKOHAU SMALL BOAT HARBOR AND KEAUHOU SMALL BOAT HARBOR

Vendor to provide labor, transportation, equipment, and any refuse containers necessary to collect and dispose of refuse from designated areas at Honokohau Small Boat Harbor (SBH) and Keauhou Small Boat Harbor in accordance with these specifications for a period of twelve months. Both facilities are located within the North Kona District of Hawaii island.

ITEMS:

- Vendor to provide refuse containers to accommodate up to 168 cubic yards of waste per week at the Honokohau SBH (see attached map for locations). Provide, 7 ea. six-yard dumpsters emptied four days per week.
- Vendor to provide refuse containers to accommodate up to 18 cubic yards of waste per week at the Keauhou SBH (see attached map for locations). Vendor to provide 1 ea. six-yard refuse container at the Keauhou SBH emptied three days per week.
- Refuse containers may be metal or plastic, shall have top lids and wheels, unless otherwise agreed.
- Refuse containers shall be uniform in appearance and kept in good working order. This includes painting, repairing damage for safety and prevention of leakage or escape of refuse, periodic clean-up of interior and exterior of containers and keeping them clean and free from obnoxious residual odors, by spraying with disinfectant at least once a week.
- Refuse containers at Honokohau SBH shall be emptied as many times per week as necessary to accommodate up to 168 cubic yards of waste each week. Containers should be emptied between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and Noon on Monday, Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday.

- The refuse container at Keauhou SBH shall be emptied as many times per week as necessary to accommodate up to 18 cubic yards of waste each week. Containers should be emptied between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and Noon on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.
- In the event the container is filled, vendor shall ensure that all refuse stacked on the ground adjacent to the container is picked up.
- Transfer of refuse from containers to refuse collection trucks shall be performed with a minimum of spillage, pollution of the atmosphere or surrounding area. The refuse collection truck shall be constructed so that refuse therein shall be well confined without any leakage, spillage, or loss of refuse during transit.
- Provide current Certificate of insurance, Signed W-9 form, and a blank invoice statement with remit to address.
- The term of contract shall be for the twelve (12) month period commencing from the official date on the Notice to Proceed but not earlier than November 1, 2026. Unless terminated, the contract may be extended without re-bidding, upon mutual agreement in writing between the State and the Contractor, prior to the expiration date, for not more than three (3) twelve (12) month extensions.
