

KAHO‘OLAWE ISLAND RESERVE COMMISSION

Invitation for Bids for Compact Telehandler

Description

The Kaho‘olawe Island Reserve Commission (KIRC) is seeking bids for the purchase of one (1) new compact off-road telehandler to support material handling, construction, restoration, maintenance, and stewardship activities on Kaho‘olawe.

The telehandler shall include standard pallet forks, one (1) compatible general-purpose front loader bucket attachment, and delivery to the KIRC Kihei Boathouse.

Due to the island's remote location and the need to transport equipment aboard KIRC's landing craft, the telehandler must provide substantial lifting capability while remaining suitable for marine transport and operation in rugged off-road conditions.

Minimum Specifications

The proposed equipment shall meet or exceed the following minimum specifications:

Forks	Standard pallet fork carriage included
Bucket	One (1) compatible general-purpose front loader bucket included
Operator Protection	ROPS/FOPS certified
Warranty	Standard manufacturer's warranty

Bid Requirements

Bidders shall submit:

- Price quotation
- Manufacturer, make, and model of proposed equipment
- Manufacturer's specification sheet
- Warranty information
- Estimated delivery timeline
- Confirmation that the proposed equipment meets or exceeds the minimum specifications listed above

Equivalent equipment meeting or exceeding these specifications will be considered.

Hawaii Compliance Express (HCE)

The successful bidder shall be compliant with all applicable State of Hawaii procurement requirements. Prior to contract award, the successful bidder shall provide a current Hawaii Compliance Express (HCE) Certificate of Vendor Compliance, if required under Chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
