SPECIFICATIONS**

JOB LOCATIONS: PUAKO BOAT RAMP

Vendor to provide labor, transportation, equipment to remove 16-20 Kiawe medium sized trees.

ITEMS:

- Vendor to provide labor, transportation, equipment, tools and materials necessary to safely remove, haul and dispose of approximately 16-20 medium sized kiawe trees located on the south side of Puako boat ramp. Some of which is hanging halfway in the ocean.
- Vendor shall cut, remove load, transport, and haul all resulting tree material and debris to an approved transfer station or disposal facility.
- Vendor shall maintain a safe and unobstructed walking path along the designated walking trail throughout the duration of the work. All losses, cut or fallen trees, branches, and debris that may present a hazard to the public's safety shall be promptly removed.
- Vendor shall leave the work area clean, orderly, and free of tree debris and the end of each workday and at the completion of the job.
- Vendor shall perform all work in a safe manner and take appropriate measures to protect the public, existing facilities, vehicles, and all surrounding residential property.
- Upon completion, vendor shall participate in a final walk-through with the Hawaii district Building Maintenance Supervisor I, Jewel Apana, to verify that all work has been completed in accordance with specifications. Any deficiencies identified during walk-through shall be corrected by the vendor prior to final acceptance.

Required Documentation

- Provide current Certificate of insurance, Signed W-9 form, and a blank invoice statement including remit to address.
