PRE-BID CONFERENCE AGENDA

1. Lead-containing paints have been assumed to be present at the existing men's and women's restrooms. Contractor shall conduct work in accordance with applicable OSHA standards.
2. Contractor shall provide and maintain temporary accessible routes around construction area in accordance with ADAAG 4.1.1(4).
3. Restroom Operation and Closure:
 - Contractor shall maintain clear access to the existing restrooms when open.
 - Contractor shall provide one (1) ADA accessible and two (2) standard portable toilets during restroom closure. Portable toilets shall be maintained three (3) times a week (Mon, Thurs, Sat).
 - Restrooms shall not be closed until portable toilets are provide onsite
 - Restrooms shall not be closed for more than thirty (30) consecutive days.
 - Restrooms shall not be closed during the months of July, August, and December.
4. Contractor shall contact the Division of State Parks, Hawaii County Archeologist to verify any archaeological protection requirements prior to construction.
5. Contractor's operations shall not impact environmentally sensitive water bodies.
6. Coordination with Adjacent Project and Contractor:
 - Kekaha Kai State Park Access Road Improvements Project may be in construction at the same time.
 - Access Road may be closed during the work week for construction improvements.
7. Contractor shall comply with all requirements of the Special Management Area (SMA) Permit and Shoreline Setback Variance (SSV) Permit. Copies of the SMA and SSV Permits will be uploaded on HIePRO.
8. Building permit application has submitted to the County for processing.

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9. Revised Proposal to be issued in next addendum.
10. Bidding:
