### **DELIVERY**

If you are having a delivery service/trucking company/vendor make the delivery for you, the reservation must be made with the following points of contact:

**NOTE: ONLY flammable goods (fuel) and tanker trucks will be accepted on 08/20/21. All other cargo must be delivered to the pier on 08/19/21.**

### **TRANSHIPMENT**

If you are bringing merchandise in from the outer islands, please notify the NPS barge contacts listed below, and we will notify Young Brothers of the transshipment. You are responsible for the logistics and expenses of shipping your items (general cargo & automobiles) from outer islands to Honolulu (YB Pier 39/40) to meet the delivery date of 08/19/21.

Please notify LeAnna Lang (240.362.2242) if you will be making a transshipment.

### **Documentation Required**

#### **VEHICLES**

Please provide the following documents when shipping vehicle(s).

1. Title or ownership for the vehicle
2. Signed statement from registered owner giving permission to another individual to ship vehicle to Kalaupapa.
3. Insurance policy for the vehicle(s)
4. Registration documents
5. Make sure the gas tank is no more than quarter (1/4) tank full before turning it over to Young Brothers at the auto station at Pier 39/40 in Honolulu and/or at the Kalaupapa pier.

1) **YOUNG BROTHERS BILL OF LADING**

The Young Brothers (YB) Bill of Lading will be used to facilitate tracking of goods received and payments to vendors. DO NOT SEPARATE the bill of lading pages before checking in with the YB freight clerk. You will be given your copy once you have checked in your delivery.

2) **YOUNG BROTHERS BLUE “MOLO” LABEL – KLPA white sticker over it**

Each pallet/skip/vehicle/container will require a special YB blue MOLO/KLPA label.

Young Brothers requires that all merchandise/goods be palletized if at all possible. In instances where the number of items (1 or 2) or the size is too small, YB will palletize and/or containerize them. You (the shipper) will be responsible for completing the bill of lading and marking all boxes/containers with the blue MOLO/KLPA label. The amount of pallets, pieces, and description MUST be stated on the Bill(s) of Lading.

Reminder: YOU are responsible for the logistics and expense of shipping your items from outer islands (**TRANSHIPMENT**) to Honolulu in order to meet scheduled loading days (see attached schedule).

**PLEASE NOTE: Any hazardous materials not on the manifest by 09 August 2021 will NOT be allowed to ship!**
