

ATTACHMENT A – SPECIFICATIONS AND OTHER PROVISIONS

TO FURNISH AND INSTALL ONE MEKEL MACH10 (OR AN EQUIVALENT MODEL) HIGH-SPEED MICROFILM SCANNER FOR THE JUDICIARY, STATE OF HAWAII

Description:

The Judiciary, State of Hawaii, is soliciting quotes for the purchase and installation of one MEKEL MACH10 (or an equivalent model) high-speed microfilm scanner.

NOTICE: This solicitation is contingent upon availability of funds.

Specifications: Vendor shall provide a quote for a microfilm scanner that includes the following features or better:

- 1) Mekel MACH10 (or Equivalent Model) High-Speed Microfilm Scanner
- 2) 700 images per minute/1,400 files per minute at 200 dpi/3 minutes per roll or higher
- 3) Scanning up to 1,000 feet in length
- 4) 100% accurate image capture
- 5) 1-year post warranty, on-site maintenance support
- 6) Film types: 100', 215' and 1,000' roll standard
- 7) 16mm/35mm; simplex/duplex; positive/negative
- 8) Workstation and monitor included
- 9) Single/multi PDF and other output formats
- 10) Film cleaning rollers
- 11) KOFAX compatible
- 12) Real-time image sharpen and enhancement
- 13) Windows 7 and higher compatible
- 14) Installation and onsite (8 hour/day) training
- 15) Includes shipping/handling, tax, and all applicable costs

Quotation: Prices offered shall include but not limited to labor charges, equipment, supplies, taxes and all other applicable costs incurred as specified. If there is a discrepancy in the prices submitted, the unit price will prevail.

Work Hours: The Judiciary's normal work hours are from 7:45 am to 4:30 pm, Hawaii Standard Time, Monday through Friday, except for State Holidays and/or days when work is not officially scheduled. Contractor's work hours shall follow the Judiciary's work hours unless specifically agreed upon by both the Contractor and the Judiciary Officer-in-Charge.

Vendor Compliance: Pursuant to HRS 103D-310(c), all Offerors, upon award of contract, shall comply with all laws governing entities doing business in the State. As such, the Judiciary recommends that vendors utilize the Hawaii Compliance Express (HCE) to obtain proof of compliance prior to award. Non-compliance may result in vendor not receiving an award.
